PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURE

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Closure of Monkstown Road, Clifton Lane

Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council Roads Maintenance Section has requested the temporary closure of **Monkstown Road** from the junction of York Road to the junction of Temple Hill, with closure point also at junction of Monkstown Avenue and Carrickbrennan Road and Clifton Lane (Cul de Sac) from **Monday 9**th **July, 2018 to 30**th **October, 2018.**

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate Road/Footpath restoration and associated work on Monkstown Road and Clifton Lane.

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Closure of Cornelscourt Hill Road, Cornelscourt, Dublin 18

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council proposes to temporarily close **Cornelscourt Hill Road** from Kerrymount Avenue to Park Drive from 08.00 a.m. to 18.00 p.m. Monday to Friday from Monday **16th July** to Friday **24th August 2018** inclusive, in order to facilitate road and footpath restoration works by the Roads Maintenance Section, Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council.

The proposed diversion route is via Brighton Road, Westminster Road, N11, Old Bray Road and vice versa.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained.

The proposed diversion route is via Woodside Road - Black Glen Road - Enniskerry Road and vice versa.

Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council proposes to temporarily close **Ballybetagh Road** from Ballyedmonduff Road to Killegar Lane from 08.00 a.m. to 18.00 p.m. Monday to Friday from **16th July** to **17th August 2018** inclusive, in order to facilitate road and footpath restoration works by the Roads Maintenance Section, Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Council.

The proposed diversion route is via Red House Road – Ballyedmonduff Road - Burrow Road - Stepaside Lane - Enniskerry Road and vice versa.

ROAD CLOSURES

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Closure of Meadow Mount and Section of Meadow Grove, Ballinteer

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order to close **Meadow Mount** and a **section of Meadow Grove, Ballinteer**. The closure is to take place from **6.30 p.m. – 9.30 p.m.** on **Wednesday 20th June, 2018.**

The purpose of the proposed closure is to facilitate The Stephen Roche Cycle Race.

Diversion of traffic will be via Barton Road East, Meadow Avenue, Meadow Grove, Willow Road and Beech Lawn and vice versa.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and the diversion routes will be signposted.

Emergency Access can be provided, if required, during the period of the road closure.

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Closure of Main Street, Dundrum

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order to close **Main Street**, **Dundrum** between its junction with Upper Kilmacud Road to just south of the entrance to the Village Centre Carpark. The closure is to take place from **1.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m.** on **Sunday 24th June**, **2018**.

The purpose of the proposed closure is to facilitate **The Dundrum Arts & Cultural Festival.**

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and all diversions will be signposted. Local access will be maintained at all times.

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Closure of Mariner's Court, Dún Laoghaire

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order to close **Mariner's Court**, **Dún Laoghaire** from Haigh Terrace to Mariners Court between the hours of **8.00 a.m.** and **7.00 p.m**. from **18th June**, **2018** to **22nd June**, **2018** inclusive, in order to facilitate gas works.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times.

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Closure of Burma Road, Killiney

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order to close **Burma Road**, **Killiney** (access Road to Killiney Hill Park) from **Dalkey Avenue to Killiney Hill Park** between the hours of **9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m.** from **18**th **June**, **2018** to **6**th **July**, **2018** inclusive, in order to facilitate road reconstruction work on Saval Park Roundabout by the Roads Maintenance Section, Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times.

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Closure of Castle Street, Dalkey

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close **Castle Street** from Allied Irish Bank to The Church of the Assumption, Castle Street, Dalkey on **Saturday 16th June, 2018 and Sunday 17th June, 2018** from **12 Noon to 6.00 p.m.** in order to promote **Dalkey Book Festival**. The purpose of the closure is to facilitate the **Street Festival Run** in conjunction with Dalkey Book Festival and to bring a festival atmosphere for community and visitors.

A Traffic Management Plan with diversion routes will be in operation and local access will be maintained for the full duration of the event.

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

» Saval Park Road/Dalkey Avenue Roundabout **

Road reconstruction works on the roundabout at Saval Park Road and Dalkey Avenue will commence on Monday, 18^{th} June until Friday, 22^{nd} June 2018 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

Road Closure of Burma Road (the access road to Killiney Hill Park) will commence on Monday, 18th June 2018 until Friday, 22nd June 2018 between 09:00 and 17:00 hrs. Pedestrian access will be maintained to Killiney Hill Park.

There will be a Stop / Go Traffic Management System in place during construction works.

» Ballinclea Road, Killiney **

Site investigation works will commence on Monday, 18th June 2018 until Friday, 29th June 2018 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» Dalkey Avenue/Castle Street *

Footpath reconstruction works will commence at Dalkey Avenue/Castle Street on Monday, 18th June 2018 until Thursday, 21st June 2018 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» 1A Dalkey Grove *

Water connection and footpath reinstatement works will commence on Monday, 18th June 2018 until Friday, 22nd June 2018 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Corke Abbey, Bray **

Snagging works will continue on Corke Abbey until Friday, 22^{nd} June 2018 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Windsor Terrace - Dún Laoghaire Baths Redevelopment ***

Construction commenced on the redevelopment of the Baths site on Monday, 23rd April 2018. Construction is programmed to be completed by Q1 2020. Works will be required on the sea side path of Windsor Terrace between Park Road and the car park to facilitate the installation of ducting and the erection of the hoarding.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for the duration of these works and lane restrictions will be between 10:00-16:00 hrs. Monday – Friday for approximately 6 weeks. Once these works are completed the construction will be confined within the site.

Public Lighting Lantern and Bracket Upgrade Works **

Public lighting lantern and bracket upgrade works will take place on:

- 1. Kilmacud Road Upper
- 2. Deansgrange Road
- 3. Blackthorn Drive
- 4. Kill Lane/Avenue
- 5. Clonskeagh Road
- 6. Leopardstown Road
- 7. Kilmacud Road Lower
- 8. Cornelscourt Hill
- 9. Avoca Ave
- 10. Monkstown Ring Road
- 11. Stradbrook Road
- 12. Sallynoggin Road

These works will continue until Friday, 21st December 2018.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation as required.

Summerhill Road / The Metals Intersection, Dún Laoghaire **

Installation of public lighting column and associated cabling. Work to commence on 11^{th} June 2018 until Friday, 22^{nd} June 2018.

A Stop /Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Deerpark Road, Mount Merrion (Mount Anville Road end) **

Public lighting column and lantern upgrade works commenced on Tuesday, 8th May 2018 until Thursday, 28th June 2018 (intermittently).

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for the duration of the work.

Shanganagh Road, Shankill **

Construction of a new footpath (which impacts on northbound traffic lane) commenced on Tuesday, 8th May 2018 until Friday, 6th July 2018 between 09:30 and 16:30 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

N11 - Northbound between the Clonkeen and Johnstown Junctions **

Public lighting column and lantern upgrade works will continue until Friday, 27th July 2018 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. and 19:30 – Midnight (if required).

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for the duration of the work.

N11 - Southbound between the Clonkeen and Johnstown Junctions **

Public lighting column and lantern upgrade works will continue until Friday, 27th July 2018 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. and 19:30 – Midnight (if required).

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for the duration of the work.

Mather Road North, Mount Merrion *

Footpath and road restoration works will commence on Monday, 11th June 2018 until Friday, 29th June 2018 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.
