- Purchase of equipment such as paint, brushes etc.
- Other improvements which are approved by the Environment Department
- A maximum of 70% of the total project amount will be awarded, the other 30% must be made up by the applicant.
- If the application is successful and once the project is complete, groups must submit a copy of receipts (not invoices) for the project to the Council. Failure to do this may result in you failing to secure funding in the future.
- Preference is given to groups who carry out any works directly, promoting sustainable community involvement over groups seeking funding to pay a contractor to carry out works.
