# Dún Laoghaire as 1916 Approached, a Social History

Dún Laoghaire was probably the most desirable place in all of Ireland in the early part of the 20th century. But behind the façades it had some dirty secrets of widespread concealed grinding poverty, disease and deprivation. Before 1916 the town saw major physical changes.
