

# **NEW NATIONAL ROAD LICENSING PROCEDURES**

## **MAPROAD ROADWORKS LICENSING (MRL)**

### **for commercial and private developments**

The national online road opening system, MapRoad Roadworks Licensing (MRL), will be in operation in Dún Laoghaire–Rathdown County Council for all commercial and private developments from **20<sup>th</sup> March 2018** in accordance with the **Guidelines for Managing Openings in Public Roads (April 2017)**. Applications through the Roadmap system and Paper based applications will no longer be accepted after **20<sup>th</sup> March 2018**.

The MRL system is managed and facilitated by the Road Management Office (RMO) [www.rmo.ie](http://www.rmo.ie) and licences will be issued through the online system by Dún Laoghaire–Rathdown County Council.

### **TRAINING**

It should be noted that in accordance with section 5.4 of the Guidelines, all licence holders registering on the MRL system are undertaking to have personnel trained as follows during 2018:

- Basic Level Trench Reinstatement Course (2 Day)
- Advanced Level Trench Reinstatement (1 Day)
