PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURES

» TEMPORARY CLOSING OF ROADS NOTICE OF INTENTION – TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF M50 JUNCTIONS 14 to17 Southbound SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, on behalf of Transport Infrastructure Ireland, gives notice in accordance with Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 that it intends to close:

- The M50 Southbound between Junction 14 (Dún Laoghaire) and Junction 17 (M11 merge).
- The M50Junction 15 southbound merge slip road
- The M50Junction 16 southbound merge slip road

Dates of the closure: August 12th – August 23rd 2019 (excluding Thursday night 15th August 2019) August 26th – September 25th 2019

Hours of closure: Monday – Sunday 10pm-6am

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate the resurfacing of the pavement.

On any given night, only one carriageway direction on the M50 shall be permitted to be closed and diverted.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and diversion routes clearly signposted, as agreed with Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Council and An Garda Síochána. Local and emergency access will be allowed at all times.

Diversion of M50 mainline traffic will be via the N31 Leopardstown Road, R113 Leopardstown Road, N11 Dual Carriageway and M11.

Diversion of traffic wishing to travel on the M50 southbound from Junction 15 will be via Murphystown Way and Ballyogan Road to M50 Junction 14. Traffic will proceed along the N31 thereafter as above.

Diversion of traffic wishing to travel on the M50 southbound from Junction 16 will be via R118 Wyattville Road, N11 Dual Carriageway, and M11.

» TEMPORARY CLOSING OF ROADS NOTICE OF INTENTION TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF M50 JUNCTIONS 14 to17 Northbound SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, on behalf of Transport Infrastructure Ireland, gives notice in accordance with Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 that it intends to close:

- The M50 Northbound between Junction 17 (M11) and Junction 14 (Dun Laoghaire).
- The M50 Junction 16 northbound merge slip road
- The M50 Junction 15 northbound merge slip road

Dates of the closure: August 25th – October 15th 2019

Hours of closure: Monday – Sunday 10pm-6am

The purpose of the closure is required to facilitate the resurfacing of the pavement.

On any given night, only one carriageway direction on the M50 shall be permitted to be closed and diverted.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and diversion routes clearly signposted, as agreed with Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council and An Garda Síochána. Local and emergency access will be allowed at all times.

Diversion of M50 mainline traffic will be via the M11, N11 Dual Carriageway, R113 Leopardstown Road and N31 Leopardstown Road.

Diversion of traffic wishing to travel on the M50 northbound from Junction 15 will be via Ballyogan Road and Murphystown Way.

Diversion of traffic wishing to travel on the M50 northbound from Junction 16 will be via R118 Wyattville Road, N11 Dual Carriageway, R113 Leopardstown Road and N31 Leopardstown Road.

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Road Closure of Castle Street, Dalkey

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application to temporarily close **Castle Street** from The Church of the Assumption, Castle Street, Dalkey to Allied Irish Bank on **Monday 5th August, 2019** from **12 Noon to 6.00 p.m.** in order to facilitate **Dalkey Vintage Festival**. The purpose of the closure is to facilitate safe parking and display of vintage cars as part of Dalkey Vintage Festival.

A Traffic Management Plan with diversion routes will be in operation and local access will be maintained for the full duration of the event.

ROAD CLOSURES

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Closure of Main Street, Dundrum

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order to close **Main Street**, **Dundrum** between its junctions with Upper Kilmacud Road to just south of the entrance to the Village Centre Carpark. The closure is to take place from **1.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m**. on **Sunday 30th June**, **2019**.

The purpose of the proposed closure is to facilitate the **Dundrum Arts & Cultural Festival.**

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and all diversions will be signposted. Local access will be maintained at all times.

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Bingo Loco Event Dún Laoghaire

Dún Laoghaire / Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close 200m of **Harbour Road** on **Saturday 13th July, 2019** between **12noon and 11.30pm** in order to facilitate the **Bingo Loco Event** in the former Stena compound.

The section of Harbour Road will be closed from the junction at the Marine Road roundabout 200m west to the junction at the Marina.

A Traffic Management will be in place and diversions will be signposted.

Longitude Concerts – Marlay Park Friday 5th to Sunday 7th July 2019

To facilitate the safe access and egress to the **Concerts in Marlay Park**, there will be traffic restriction measures in place on **Grange Road** and the surrounding road network.

Grange Road and section of the approach roads will be closed each evening after the Concerts from **10.00pm to Midnight**, (in the interest of pedestrian safety).

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

» N11 Cabinteely (traffic restricted to one lane only in each direction) *** (Night Works)

Night works are required to carry out road crossings on N11 Cabinteely on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday – 8th 9th 10th respectively.

Monday – Northbound carriageway – one lane only Tuesday – Northbound and Southbound carriageways – each one lane only Wednesday – Southbound carriageway – one lane only.

Night works will commence at 7.30 pm until 12.30 am.

Restricted cycle lane and footpath provision will be provided.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» Sandyford Road *** from M50 bridge to Kilcross estate

Construction of a new pedestrian crossing on the Sandyford Road south of the Kilcross estate will commence on Monday July 8th and take three weeks.

Traffic Management will be in place between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs on weekdays.

» Dublin Road Shankill – at the Junction with Olcovar **

The Construction of a new Signalised Pedestrian crossing will commence on the Dublin Road Shankill on Monday, 8th July 2019 until Friday, 19th July 2019 between 09:30 and 17:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times.

» Castlebrook, Dundrum *

Footpath repair works will continue until Friday, 12th July 2019 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» Balally Estate, Dundrum *

Footpath repair works will commence on Monday, 8th July 2019 until Friday, 12th July 2019 between 09:30 and 16:30 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Clonskeagh Road *** from Leinster Lawn to Whitethorn Road (Night Works)

Upgrade of pedestrian and cycling facilities along Clonskeagh Road will commence on Monday, 4th March 2019.

Permanent Traffic Management will be in place <u>until end of July 2019</u> with lane closures between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. on weekdays.

Night works to take place from 8th - 10th July.

Monkstown Road, Monkstown **

Inspection of carriageway ironworks will continue until Friday, 12th July 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Semi Static Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

N11 Cabinteely (closure of south bound bus lane) ***

Closure of south bound bus lane and restrictions on cycle lane will commence on Tuesday 30th April between 10.00 and 16.00 hrs. to facilitate road widening works north of Circle K filing station on east side of N11. This phase of the works is scheduled for completion end of July 2019.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

N11 Cabinteely (closure of bus lane - north bound carriageway only) ***

Works will commence on Tuesday, 26th February 2019 to construct a new signalized junction and construction of 135 m of new Druid's Glen Road until autumn 2019.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

N31 – from its Junction with Royal Marine Road to its Junction with Newtown Avenue ** (Night Works)

GPR survey works will continue until Friday 19th July 2019 between 20:00 and 05:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times.

Public Lighting Lantern and Bracket Upgrade Works **

Public lighting lantern and bracket upgrade works will take place on:

- 1. Glenageary Road Lower
- 2. Deansgrange Road
- 3. Mounttown Road
- 4. Abbey Road
- 5. Clonskeagh Road
- 6. Leopardstown Road
- 7. Glenageary Road upper
- 8. York Road
- 9. Stradbrook Road
- 10. Sandyford Business Park

These works will continue until Friday 29th November 2019.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation as required.

N11 and N31 National Road Re-Signing Contract **

Work has commenced on the upgrade of traffic directional signage at various junctions along the N11 and N31. The project involves the removal and disposal of existing signage, construction/installation of new sign faces, sign face panels and patches, and new posts/supports and foundations at a number of locations.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for each phase of the works. Phase 2 of works will take place on N31 (Leopardstown Road). Traffic lane restrictions or footway /cycle track restrictions may apply for each phase of the works.

Windsor Terrace – Dún Laoghaire Baths Redevelopment **

Construction commenced on the redevelopment of the Baths site on Monday, 23rd April 2018. Construction is programmed to be completed by Q1 2020.

During **July**, pier bench and skin wall construction will be completed. Internal construction of the building will continue with the upper level services / floors / walls being installed. Construction of the new sea walls and various other walls on the site will continue. There should be no Traffic Management restrictions on Windsor Terrace with the exception of the delivery of materials, which will be short term and between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. Monday – Friday.
