PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURES

» TEMPORARY CLOSING OF ROADS NOTICE OF INTENTION –TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF M50 JUNCTIONS **14 to 17 Southbound** SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, on behalf of Transport Infrastructure Ireland, gives notice in accordance with Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 that it intends to close:

- The M50 Southbound between Junction 14 (Dún Laoghaire) and Junction 17 (M11 merge).
- The M50 Junction 15 southbound merge slip road
- The M50 Junction 16 southbound merge slip road

Dates of the closure:

August 12th – August 23rd 2019 (excluding Thursday night 15th August 2019)

August 26th – September 25th 2019

Hours of closure:

Monday – Sunday 10pm-6am

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate the resurfacing of the pavement.

On any given night, only one carriageway direction on the M50 shall be permitted to be closed and diverted.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and diversion routes clearly signposted, as agreed with Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Council and An Garda Síochána. Local and emergency access will be allowed at all times.

Diversion of M50 mainline traffic will be via the N31 Leopardstown Road, R113 Leopardstown Road, N11 Dual Carriageway and M11.

Diversion of traffic wishing to travel on the M50 southbound from Junction 15 will be via Murphystown Way and Ballyogan Road to M50 Junction 14. Traffic will proceed along the N31 thereafter as above.

Diversion of traffic wishing to travel on the M50 southbound from Junction 16 will be via R118 Wyattville Road, N11 Dual Carriageway, and M11.

NOTICE OF INTENTION TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF M50 JUNCTIONS
14 to 17 Northbound
SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, on behalf of Transport Infrastructure Ireland, gives notice in accordance with Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 that it intends to close:

- The M50 Northbound between Junction 17 (M11) and Junction 14 (Dun Laoghaire).
- The M50 Junction 16 northbound merge slip road
- The M50 Junction 15 northbound merge slip road

Dates of the closure:
August 25th – October 15th 2019

Hours of closure:
Monday – Sunday 10pm-6am

The purpose of the closure is required to facilitate the resurfacing of the pavement.

On any given night, only one carriageway direction on the M50 shall be permitted to be closed and diverted.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and diversion routes clearly signposted, as agreed with Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council and An Garda Síochána. Local and emergency access will be allowed at all times.

Diversion of M50 mainline traffic will be via the M11, N11 Dual Carriageway, R113 Leopardstown Road and N31 Leopardstown Road.

Diversion of traffic wishing to travel on the M50 northbound from Junction 15 will be via Ballyogan Road and Murphystown Way.

Diversion of traffic wishing to travel on the M50 northbound from Junction 16 will be via R118 Wyattville Road, N11 Dual Carriageway, R113 Leopardstown Road and N31 Leopardstown Road.

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Road Closure of Castle Street, Dalkey

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application to temporarily close **Castle Street** from The Church of the Assumption, Castle Street, Dalkey to Allied Irish Bank on **Monday 5th August, 2019** from **12 Noon to 6.00 p.m.** in order to facilitate **Dalkey Vintage Festival**. The purpose of the closure is to facilitate safe parking and display of vintage cars as part of Dalkey Vintage Festival.

A Traffic Management Plan with diversion routes will be in operation and local access will be maintained for the full duration of the event.

ROAD CLOSURES

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Bingo Loco Event Dún Laoghaire

Dún Laoghaire / Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close 200m of **Harbour Road** on **Saturday 13th July, 2019** between **12noon and 11.30pm** in order to facilitate the **Bingo Loco Event** in the former Stena compound.

The section of Harbour Road will be closed from the junction at the Marine Road roundabout 200m west to the junction at the Marina.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and diversions will be signposted.

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

» **Brennanstown Road, Foxrock – new Residential Development *****

New footpath, traffic roundabout, road resurfacing and the installation of utility services will commence on Monday, 15th July 2019 until Friday, 15th November 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **N11 – Stillorgan – St. John of God Hospital *****

Tree trimming works will commence on Tuesday, 23rd July 2019 until Friday, 25th July 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **Queen’s Road, Dún Laoghaire *****

Footpath restoration works will commence on Monday, 15th July 2019 until Friday, 2nd August 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times.

» **Kilmacud Road Upper – Junction with The Hill, Old Dublin Road ** (Night Works)**

Crane off-loading works will commence on Monday, 15th July 2019 and Tuesday 16th July between 22:00 and 06:00 hrs. each day.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times.

» **Brighton Road, Foxrock ****

Road resurfacing and lining will commence on Monday, 15th July 2019 until Friday, 19th July 2019 between 08:00 and 16:30 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **Proby Square / Upper Carysfort Avenue, Blackrock ****

Road trench reinstatement works on behalf of ESB will commence on Monday, 15th July 2019 until Friday, 19th July 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **Church Road – portion of R118 and traffic island at and adjacent to the Graduate Roundabout ****

Essential cleansing works will commence on Friday, 12th and Monday, 15th July 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **Dublin Road Shankill – at the Junction with Olcovar ****

The construction of a new signalised pedestrian crossing will commence on the Dublin Road Shankill on Monday, 15th July 2019 until Friday, 19th July 2019 between 09:30 and 17:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times.

» **Eblana Avenue, Dún Laoghaire ****

Road and footpath reconstruction works will commence on Monday 15th July until Thursday, 18th July 2019 between 08:00 and 17:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management System will be in operation on Eblana Avenue/Marine Road between 08:00 and 17:00 hrs.

» **Glenamuck Road and Enniskerry Road Junction – at the Golden Ball ****

Watermain works will commence on Monday, 15th July 2019 until Friday, 19th July 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **Valeview Avenue, The Park Cabinteely ***

Surfacing overlay works will commence on Monday, 15th July 2019 until Friday, 16th August 2019 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **Lower Kilmacud Road, Kilmacud ***

Road surfacing works will commence on Monday, 15th July 2019 until *Friday, 16th August 2019* between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Balally Estate, Dundrum *

Surfacing overlay works will commence on Monday, 15th July 2019 until Friday, 19th July 2019 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Sandyford Road *
from M50 bridge to Kilcross estate**

Construction of a new pedestrian crossing on the Sandyford Road south of the Kilcross estate commenced on Monday, 8th July and will take *three weeks*.

Traffic Management will be in place between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs on weekdays.

N11 Cabinteely (closure of north and south bound bus lanes) ***

Closure of north and south bound bus lanes and restrictions on cycle lanes will continue in order to facilitate road widening works near both Circle K filling stations on N11, Cabinteely. This phase of the works is scheduled for completion *September 2019*.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Clonskeagh Road *
from Leinster Lawn to Whitethorn Road
(Night Works)**

Upgrade of pedestrian and cycling facilities along Clonskeagh Road commenced on Monday, 4th March 2019.

Permanent Traffic Management will be in place until end of July 2019 with lane closures between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. on weekdays.

Night works to take place during weeknights.

N11 Cabinteely (closure of south bound bus lane) ***

Closure of south bound bus lane and restrictions on cycle lane will commence on Tuesday 30th April between 10.00 and 16.00 hrs. to facilitate road widening works north of Circle K filling station on east side of N11. This phase of the works is scheduled for completion end of July 2019.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

N11 Cabinteely (closure of bus lane – north bound carriageway only) ***

Works will commence on Tuesday, 26th February 2019 to construct a new signalized junction and construction of 135 m of new Druid's Glen Road until autumn 2019.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

N31 – from its Junction with Royal Marine Road to its Junction with Newtown Avenue ** (Night Works)

GPR survey works will continue until Friday 19th July 2019 between 20:00 and 05:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times.

Public Lighting Lantern and Bracket Upgrade Works **

Public lighting lantern and bracket upgrade works will take place on:

1. Glenageary Road Lower
2. Deansgrange Road
3. Mounttown Road
4. Abbey Road
5. Clonskeagh Road
6. Leopardstown Road
7. Glenageary Road upper
8. York Road
9. Stradbrook Road
10. Sandyford Business Park

These works will continue until *Friday 29th November 2019.*

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation as required.

N11 and N31 National Road Re-Signing Contract **

Work has commenced on the upgrade of traffic directional signage at various junctions along the N11 and N31. The project involves the removal and disposal of existing signage, construction/installation of new sign faces, sign face panels and patches, and new posts/supports and foundations at a number of locations.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for each phase of the works. Phase 2 of works will take place on N31 (Leopardstown Road). Traffic lane restrictions or footway /cycle track restrictions may apply for each phase of the works.

Windsor Terrace – Dún Laoghaire Baths Redevelopment **

Construction commenced on the redevelopment of the Baths site on Monday, 23rd April 2018. Construction is programmed to be completed by Q1 2020.

During **July**, pier bench and skin wall construction will be completed. Internal construction of the building will continue with the upper level services / floors / walls being installed. Construction of the new sea walls and various other walls on the site will continue. There should be no Traffic Management restrictions on Windsor Terrace with the exception of the delivery of materials, which will be short term and between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. Monday – Friday.
