#### PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURES

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Closure of roads within Sandyford Business District to facilitate the Spirit Sandyford 5K Race - 2019

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from Dundrum South Dublin Athletic Club, in association with Sandyford Business District Association, for a partial to full closure of a number of roads within Sandyford Business District on **Thursday, 26<sup>th</sup> September 2019** to facilitate the **Spirit Sandyford 5K Race – 2019**.

The Start Time of the Race is 7.30 p.m.

It is envisaged that the roads will be closed at **7.15 p.m.** and will remain closed until after the completion of the race at **8.30 p.m.** 

The Roads affected are as follows:

- 1. Blackthorn Road, (Partial)
- 2. Blackthorn Avenue, (Partial)
- 3. Carmanhall Road
- 4. Three Rock Road
- 5. Corrig Road
- 6. Raven's Rock Road

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and all diversion routes will be clearly sign-posted.

Emergency Access can be provided, if required, during the period of the road closures.

#### **ROAD CLOSURES**

## Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Closure of Tivoli Road and Corrig Road \*\*\*

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close **Tivoli Road and Corrig Road**, from the junction of Tivoli Road with York Road to the Junction of Corrig Road with Glenageary Road Lower from **6**<sup>th</sup> **August, 2019** to **20**<sup>th</sup> **September, 2019**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times and diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate road restoration and associated works.

Phase 1 - Road/Footpath Restoration and associated works will start during week commencing: **Monday, 12<sup>th</sup> August 2019** for duration of **6-Weeks**. Works will be undertaken between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs. (Monday to Saturday)

A Traffic Management Plan and signed detours will be in operation and local access will be maintained.

Traffic Management arrangements will remain in place over night for the duration of the works.

### **ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS**

### » Nutgrove Avenue Improvement Works \*\*\*

Road Maintenance Section is carrying out road restoration / road surfacing works on Nutgrove Avenue in the coming months from the junction with Nutgrove Way to the Church of the Good Shepherd adjacent to Oakdown Road. In advance of this, minor works will be carried out along part of the route to improve cycling facilities at the junctions and along the route.

The outline programme of works is as follows:

- Cycle track improvement works 9<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> September 2019. Hours of work 10:00 to 16:00 hrs.
- Groundworks/ Road Restoration works October to November Mainly night works

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for the duration of the works

Traffic lane restrictions or footway/cycle track restrictions may apply for each phase of the works.

### » Haigh Terrace and Lower Georges Street, Dún Laoghaire \*\*\*

Clonmel Enterprise Ltd. have been appointed by Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council to undertake the Dún Laoghaire Upgrade Scheme along Haigh Terrace, Metals Walkway and Lower George's Street.

The works will commence on the 2nd of September 2019 and run for 16 Consecutive weeks. When complete the project will create a significantly better environment and better pedestrian connection between the seafront and the town.

The works at Haigh Terrace will commence on the 2nd of September and undertaken on a phased basis with working hours restricted between 08:00 and 18:00hrs.

Clonmel Enterprises Ltd. will implement various Traffic Management Plans along Haigh Terrace with access along Haigh Terrace and the Maritime Museum maintained.

The on-street parking spaces along Haigh Terrace will be suspended for the duration of the works.

### » Old Connaught Avenue/Dublin Road, Bray \*\*

Works are being carried out on the Old Connaught Avenue / Dublin Road in Bray by GMC on behalf of Irish Water from Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> August until Monday, 9<sup>th</sup> September 2019.

There will be no access to Old Connaught Avenue from the Dublin Road.

A diversion is in place via Dargle Road, Fassaroe and Junction 5 North.

# » Sandyford Road \*\* at the entrance to the Council Depot

Re-alignment of the cycle track at the entrance to the Council Depot to commence on or after Monday, 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2019.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. on weekdays.

### » Brighton Road, Foxrock \*\*

Service Connection works for Four Ferns Nursing Home Development on Brighton Road, Foxrock will commence on Monday, 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2019 between the hours of 10:00 and 16:00 daily for duration of 2-weeks.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management System and Lane restrictions will be in place for the duration of the works.

Marshalls will work to facilitate the safe movement of all road users.

### » N11 Northbound Carriageway opposite Foxrock Church \*\*\*

Civil works will commence on the inbound lane on the cycle track and footpath at the junction of Springfield on Monday, 2<sup>nd</sup> September until Wednesday, 4<sup>th</sup> September 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place. Bus lane and Cycle lane will be closed.

### » Kilmacud House / Kilmacud Road Upper \*\*\*

John Sisk & Son (Holding) Ltd. will commence the drainage works along Kilmacud Road Upper to service a new development at Kilmacud House on Monday, 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2019 until Friday, 13<sup>th</sup> September 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

# # N11 Cabinteely (closure of bus lane - north bound and southbound carriageways) \*\*\*

Works commenced on Tuesday, 26<sup>th</sup> February 2019 to construct a new signalized junction and construction of 135 m of new Druid's Glen Road until December 2019.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

### George's Avenue on Frascati Park Side (part of) \*

Footpath restoration works commenced on Monday, 26<sup>th</sup> August 2019 until Friday, 20<sup>th</sup> September 2019 between 09:00 and 17:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times.

### Rosemeen Garden / Granite Hall \*

Footpath restoration works commenced on Monday, 26<sup>th</sup> August 2019 until Friday, 20<sup>th</sup> September 2019 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times.

### Frascati at George's Avenue Junction, Blackrock \*\*\*

Trenching and ducting works on behalf of ESB Networks will continue until Friday, 6<sup>th</sup> September 2019 between 07:00 and 11:00 hrs. - Monday to Wednesday and between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. - Thursday to Friday.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

### N11 and N31 National Road Re-Signing Contract \*\*

Work has commenced on the upgrade of traffic directional signage at various junctions along the N11 and N31. The project involves the removal and disposal of existing signage, construction/installation of new sign faces, sign face panels and patches, and new posts/supports and foundations at a number of locations.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for works on the N11 and N31. Traffic lane restrictions or footway/cycle track restrictions may apply for each phase of the works.

### Honeypark Permeability, Sallynoggin area \*\*\*

Cosgrave Developments will carry out works as part of the granted planning permissions to provide pedestrian/cycleway links from Honeypark Development through/to Sefton, Sallynoggin Park, O'Rourke Park and Rollins Villas.

The outline programme of works is as follows:

- Sefton Link and Sallynoggin Park Link 14<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2019
- O'Rourke Park/Rollins Villas Link 26<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> August 2019

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation as required.

### Clonskeagh Road, Clonskeagh \*\*\* from Leinster Lawn to Whitethorn Road

Upgrade of pedestrian and cycling facilities along Clonskeagh Road commenced on Monday, 4<sup>th</sup> March 2019.

Permanent Traffic Management will be in place *until end of August 2019* with traffic restrictions between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. on weekdays.

### Brennanstown Road, Foxrock - new Residential Development \*\*\*

New footpath, traffic roundabout, road resurfacing and the installation of utility services commenced on Monday, 15<sup>th</sup> July 2019 until Friday, 15<sup>th</sup> November 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

### N11 Cabinteely (closure of north and south bound bus lanes) \*\*\*

Closure of north and south bound bus lanes and restrictions on cycle lanes will continue in order to facilitate road widening works near both Circle K filing stations on N11, Cabinteely. This phase of the works is scheduled for completion *September 2019*.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

### Public Lighting Lantern and Bracket Upgrade Works \*\*

Public lighting lantern and bracket upgrade works will take place on:

- 1. Glenageary Road Lower
- 2. Deansgrange Road
- 3. Mounttown Road
- 4. Abbey Road
- 5. Clonskeagh Road
- 6. Leopardstown Road
- 7. Glenageary Road upper
- 8. York Road
- 9. Stradbrook Road
- 10. Sandyford Business Park

These works will continue until Friday 29th November 2019.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation as required.

### Windsor Terrace - Dún Laoghaire Baths Redevelopment \*\*

Construction commenced on the redevelopment of the Baths site on Monday, 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2018. Construction is programmed to be completed by Q1 2020.

During **September**, internal construction of the building will continue with the upper level services / floors / walls being installed. Construction of the new sea walls and various other walls on the site will continue. There should be no Traffic Management restrictions on Windsor Terrace with the exception of the delivery of materials, which will be short term and between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. Monday – Friday.
