### ROAD WORKS SPEED LIMIT ORDER

#### **Road Works Speed Limit Order, No. 1 of 2019 on the M50 Motorway in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown**

Notice is hereby given that Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004, in the interests of road safety and to facilitate the resurfacing of the M50 Motorway, has made an Order entitled:

**Road Works Speed Limit Order, No.1 of 2019 on the M50 Motorway in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown** to apply a road works speed limit as follows:

#### **M50 Southbound:**

**will run from 09/09/2019 until 11/10/2019  
or for the duration of the works whichever is the earlier.**

Description of speed limit order **80km/hr:**

- Part of the Southbound M50 between a point 120 metres South of the existing R117 overbridge to a point 620 metres South of the R117 overbridge (Total 500m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 diverge at Junction 14 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 420 metres West of the yield line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 14 (Total 485m in length).

Description of speed limit order **60km/hr:**

- Part of the Southbound M50 between a point 620 metres South of the existing R117 overbridge to a point 120 metres South of the M11 overbridge (M50 Junction 17/M11 J4)  
(Total 8,000m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 merge at Junction 13 from a point 50 metres East of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 13 to the end of the merge taper  
(Total 1250m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 diverge at Junction 15 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 40 metres West of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 15  
(Total 555m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 merge at Junction 15 from a point 75 metres South of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 15 to the end of the merge taper  
(Total 480m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 diverge at Junction 16 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 60 metres West of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 16  
(Total 525m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 merge at Junction 16 from a point 65 metres South of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 16 to the end of the merge taper  
(Total 575m in length).

**M50 Northbound:**

**will run from 23/09/2019 until 08/11/2019  
or for the duration of the works whichever is the earlier.**

Description of speed limit order **80km/hr:**

- Part of the Northbound M50 between a point 335 metres South of the existing Crinken Lane over bridge to a point 165 metres North of the Crinken Lane overbridge  
(Total 500m in length).

Description of speed limit order **60km/hr:**

- Part of the Northbound M50 between a point 165 metres North of the existing Crinken Lane overbridge to a point 300 metres West of the R113 overbridge  
(Total 8000m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 17 (M11 Junction 4) from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 70 metres North of the Lordello Road overbridge  
(Total 450m in length).

- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 16 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 55 metres East of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 16  
(Total 605m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 merge at Junction 16 from a point 80 metres West of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 16 to the end of the merge taper  
(Total 700m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 15 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 130 metres East of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 15  
(Total 500m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 merge at Junction 15 from a point 35 metres North of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 15 to the end of the merge taper  
(Total 590m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 13 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 420 metres East of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 13  
(Total 480m in length).

## ROAD CLOSURES

### TEMPORARY CLOSING OF ROADS NOTICE OF INTENTION – TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF M50 JUNCTIONS 14 to 17 Southbound SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993

#### (Night Works)

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, **on behalf of Transport Infrastructure Ireland**, gives notice in accordance with Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 that it intends to close:

- The M50 **Southbound** between Junction 14 (Dún Laoghaire) and Junction 17 (M11 merge).
- The M50 Junction 15 **southbound** merge slip road
- The M50 Junction 16 **southbound** merge slip road

#### Dates of the closure:

**25<sup>th</sup> September, 2019 – 11<sup>th</sup> October, 2019.**

#### Hours of closure:

**Monday – Sunday 10pm-6am**

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate the resurfacing of the pavement.

On any given night, only one carriageway direction on the M50 shall be permitted to be closed and diverted.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and diversion routes clearly signposted, as agreed with Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council and An Garda Síochána. Local and emergency access will be allowed at all times.

Diversion of M50 mainline traffic will be via the N31 Leopardstown Road, R113 Leopardstown Road, N11 Dual Carriageway and M11.

Diversion of traffic wishing to travel on the M50 southbound from Junction 15 will be via Murphystown Way and Ballyogan Road to M50 Junction 14. Traffic will proceed along the N31 thereafter as above.

Diversion of traffic wishing to travel on the M50 southbound from Junction 16 will be via R118 Wyattville Road, N11 Dual Carriageway, and M11.

**(Night Works)**

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, **on behalf of Transport Infrastructure Ireland**, gives notice in accordance with Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 that it intends to close:

- The M50 **Northbound** between Junction 17 (M11) and Junction 14 (Dún Laoghaire).
- The M50 Junction 16 **northbound** merge slip road
- The M50 Junction 15 **northbound** merge slip road

**Dates of the closure:**

**October 14<sup>th</sup> – November 8<sup>th</sup>, 2019**

**Hours of closure:**

**Monday – Sunday 10pm-6am**

The purpose of the closure is required to facilitate the resurfacing of the pavement.

On any given night, only one carriageway direction on the M50 shall be permitted to be closed and diverted.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and diversion routes clearly signposted, as agreed with Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council and An Garda Síochána. Local and emergency access will be allowed at all times.

Diversion of M50 mainline traffic will be via the M11, N11 Dual Carriageway, R113 Leopardstown Road and N31 Leopardstown Road.

Diversion of traffic wishing to travel on the M50 northbound from Junction 15 will be via Ballyogan Road and Murphystown Way.

Diversion of traffic wishing to travel on the M50 northbound from Junction 16 will be via R118 Wyattville Road, N11 Dual Carriageway, R113 Leopardstown Road and N31 Leopardstown Road.

**Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993**  
**Temporary Closure of roads within Sandyford Business District to facilitate the Spirit Sandyford 5K Race - 2019**

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order for a partial to full closure of a number of roads within Sandyford Business District on **Thursday, 26<sup>th</sup> September 2019** to facilitate the **Spirit Sandyford 5K Race – 2019**.

The Start Time of the Race is **7.30 p.m.**

It is envisaged that the roads will be closed at **7.15 p.m.** and will remain closed until after the completion of the race at **8.30 p.m.**

The Roads affected are as follows:

1. Blackthorn Road, (Partial)
2. Blackthorn Avenue, (Partial)
3. Carmanhall Road
4. Three Rock Road
5. Corrig Road
6. Raven's Rock Road

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and all diversion routes will be clearly sign-posted.

Emergency Access can be provided, if required, during the period of the road closures.

**Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993**  
**Temporary Closure of Carrickbrennan Road, Monkstown**

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close a section of **Carrickbrennan Road** between Richmond Green and the junction with Monkstown Road between the hours of **12.00 noon and 9.00 p.m.** inclusive on: **Saturday, 21<sup>st</sup> September 2019** in order to facilitate Street performances by **Monkstown International Puppet Festival**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained.

**# Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993**  
**Temporary Closure of Tivoli Road and Corrig Road \*\*\***

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close **Tivoli Road and Corrig Road**, from the junction of Tivoli Road with York Road to the Junction of Corrig Road with Glenageary Road Lower from **6<sup>th</sup> August, 2019** to **18<sup>th</sup> October 2019**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times and diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate road restoration and associated works.

Works will be undertaken between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs. (Monday to Saturday).

A Traffic Management Plan and signed detours will be in operation and local access will be maintained.

Traffic Management arrangements will remain in place over night for the duration of the works.

## ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

### » **Frascati Road, Blackrock \*\*\*** **(Night Works)**

Cabling works on behalf of ESB will commence on Monday, 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2019 for one day between 19:00 and 23:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

### » **Enniskerry Road / Kilgobbin Road – Stepside Garda Station \*\***

Works will commence on Monday, 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2019 for one day between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go will be in place at the above junction in order to facilitate the erection of scaffolding on the facade of Stepside Garda Station.

### » **Enniskerry Road / Kilgobbin Road – Stepside Garda Station \*\*** **(Night Works)**

The Left Slip Lane coming from Enniskerry Road onto Kilgobbin Road, travelling from Sandyford will be closed from Monday, 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2019 until Friday, 4<sup>th</sup> October 2019 between 23:40 and 06:00 hrs.

A Diversion will be in place via Glenamuck Road.

### » **Loop Road - Broadford Rise Junction of Broadford Road \*\***

Civil works will commence on Monday, 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2019 until Friday, 27<sup>th</sup> September 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

### » **Claremont Road, Foxrock \*\***

Service Connection works for Four Ferns Nursing Home Development, Brighton Road, Foxrock will commence on Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> September 2019 between the hours of 08:00 and 16:30.

The road works will take place on Claremont Road and these works are planned to be completed within one day.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management System and Lane restrictions will be in place for the duration of the works.

» **George's Avenue, Blackrock \*\*\***  
**(Night Works)**

Cable pulling works will commence on Monday, 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2019 for one day between 19:00 and 23:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» **Shanganagh Road / Dublin Road, Shankill \*\***

Works are being carried out on Shanganagh Road / Dublin Road by GMC on behalf of Irish Water on Monday, 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2019 from 09:30 until 16:30 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

# **Old Connaught Avenue/Dublin Road, Bray \*\***

Works are being carried out on the Old Connaught Avenue / Dublin Road in Bray by GMC on behalf of Irish Water from Tuesday, 6<sup>th</sup> August until Friday, 11<sup>th</sup> October 2019.

The Contractor GMC will also carry out road restoration on behalf of DLRCC Roads Maintenance Section from Monday, 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2019.

There will be no access to Old Connaught Avenue from the Dublin Road.

A diversion is in place via Dargle Road, Fassaroe and Junction 5 North.

# **Sandyford Road - at the entrance to the Council Depot \*\***

Re-alignment of the cycle track at the entrance to the Council Depot commenced on Monday, 9<sup>th</sup> September 2019 until Friday, 27<sup>th</sup> September 2019.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. on weekdays.

# **Kilmacud House / Kilmacud Road Upper \*\*\***

John Sisk & Son (Holding) Ltd. commenced the drainage works along Kilmacud Road Upper to service a new development at Kilmacud House on Monday, 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2019 until Friday, 4<sup>th</sup> October 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

# **Rosemeen Garden / Granite Hall, Dún Laoghaire \***

Footpath restoration works commenced on Monday, 26<sup>th</sup> August 2019 until Friday, 27<sup>th</sup> September 2019 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times.



### **Public Lighting Lantern and Bracket Upgrade Works \*\***

Public lighting lantern and bracket upgrade works will commence on:  
Monday, 16<sup>th</sup> September 2019 on:

1. Glenageary Road Lower
2. Killiney Road
3. Tivoli Road
4. Avondale Road
5. Ballinclea Road
6. Leopardstown Road
7. Glenageary Road upper
8. York Road
9. Vico Road
10. Sandyford Business Park

These works will continue until *Friday, 20<sup>th</sup> December 2019*.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation as required.

### **Nutgrove Avenue Improvement Works \*\*\***

Road Maintenance Section is carrying out road restoration / road surfacing works on Nutgrove Avenue in the coming months from the junction with Nutgrove Way to the Church of the Good Shepherd adjacent to Oakdown Road. In advance of this, minor works will be carried out along part of the route to improve cycling facilities at the junctions and along the route.

The outline programme of works is as follows:

- Cycle track improvement works – from 9<sup>th</sup> September 2019 for 3-4 weeks. Hours of work - 10:00 to 16:00 hrs.
- Ground works/ Road Restoration works - October to November - Mainly night works.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for the duration of the works

Traffic lane restrictions or footway/cycle track restrictions may apply for each phase of the works.

### **Haigh Terrace and Lower George's Street, Dún Laoghaire \*\*\***

Clonmel Enterprise Ltd. have been appointed by Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council to undertake the Dún Laoghaire Upgrade Scheme along Haigh Terrace, Metals Walkway and Lower George's Street.

The works will commence on 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2019 and run for 16 consecutive weeks. When complete the project will create a significantly better environment and better pedestrian connection between the seafront and the town.

The works at Haigh Terrace commenced on 2<sup>nd</sup> September and undertaken on a phased basis with working hours restricted between 08:00 and 18:00hrs.

Clonmel Enterprises Ltd. will implement various Traffic Management Plans along Haigh Terrace with access along Haigh Terrace and the Maritime Museum maintained.

The on-street parking spaces along Haigh Terrace will be suspended for the duration of the works.

**N11 Cabinteely  
(Closure of bus lane – Northbound and Southbound carriageways) \*\*\***

Works commenced on Tuesday, 26<sup>th</sup> February 2019 to construct a new signalized junction and construction of 135 m of new Druid's Glen Road until *December 2019*.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

**N11 and N31 National Road Re-Signing Contract \*\***

Work has commenced on the upgrade of traffic directional signage at various junctions along the N11 and N31. The project involves the removal and disposal of existing signage, construction/installation of new sign faces, sign face panels and patches, and new posts/supports and foundations at a number of locations.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for works on the N11 and N31. Traffic lane restrictions or footway/cycle track restrictions may apply for each phase of the works.

**Brennanstown Road, Foxrock – new Residential Development \*\*\***

New footpath, traffic roundabout, road resurfacing and the installation of utility services commenced on Monday, 15<sup>th</sup> July 2019 until Friday, 15<sup>th</sup> November 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

**N11 Cabinteely (Closure of North and Southbound bus lanes) \*\*\***

Closure of north and southbound bus lanes and restrictions on cycle lanes will continue in order to facilitate road widening works near both Circle K filling stations on N11, Cabinteely. This phase of the works is scheduled for completion *September 2019*.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

**Windsor Terrace – Dún Laoghaire Baths Redevelopment \*\***

Construction commenced on the redevelopment of the Baths site on Monday, 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2018. Construction is programmed to be completed by Q1 2020.

During **September**, internal construction of the building will continue with the upper level services / floors / walls being installed. Construction of the new sea walls and various other walls on the site will continue. There should be no Traffic Management restrictions on Windsor Terrace with the exception of the delivery of materials, which will be short term and between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. Monday – Friday.
