ROAD WORKS SPEED LIMIT ORDER

Road Works Speed Limit Order, No. 1 of 2019 on the M50 Motorway in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown

Notice is hereby given that Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004, in the interests of road safety and to facilitate the resurfacing of the M50 Motorway, has made an Order entitled:

Road Works Speed Limit Order, No.1 of 2019 on the M50 Motorway in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown to apply a road works speed limit as follows:

M50 Southbound:

will run from 09/09/2019 until 11/10/2019 or for the duration of the works whichever is the earlier.

Description of speed limit order **80km/hr:**

- Part of the Southbound M50 between a point 120 metres South of the existing R117 overbridge to a point 620 metres South of the R117 overbridge (Total 500m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 diverge at Junction 14 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 420 metres West of the yield line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 14 (Total 485m in length).

Description of speed limit order 60km/hr:

- Part of the Southbound M50 between a point 620 metres South of the existing R117 overbridge to a point 120 metres South of the M11 overbridge (M50 Junction 17/M11 J4) (Total 8,000m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 merge at Junction 13 from a point 50 metres East of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 13 to the end of the merge taper (Total 1250m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 diverge at Junction 15 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 40 metres West of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 15 (Total 555m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 merge at Junction 15 from a point 75 metres South of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 15 to the end of the merge taper (Total 480m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 diverge at Junction 16 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 60 metres West of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 16 (Total 525m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 merge at Junction 16 from a point 65 metres South of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 16 to the end of the merge taper (Total 575m in length).

M50 Northbound:

will run from 23/09/2019 until 08/11/2019 or for the duration of the works whichever is the earlier.

Description of speed limit order **80km/hr:**

 Part of the Northbound M50 between a point 335 metres South of the existing Crinken Lane over bridge to a point 165 metres North of the Crinken Lane overbridge (Total 500m in length).

Description of speed limit order 60km/hr:

- Part of the Northbound M50 between a point 165 metres North of the existing Crinken Lane overbridge to a point 300 metres West of the R113 overbridge (Total 8000m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 17 (M11 Junction 4) from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 70 metres North of the Lordello Road overbridge (Total 450m in length).

- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 16 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 55 metres East of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 16 (Total 605m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 merge at Junction 16 from a point 80 metres West of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 16 to the end of the merge taper (Total 700m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 15 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 130 metres East of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 15 (Total 500m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 merge at Junction 15 from a point 35 metres North of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 15 to the end of the merge taper (Total 590m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 13 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 420 metres East of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 13 (Total 480m in length).

PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURES

» Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Closure of Devitt Villas, Glasthule

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from Gas Networks Ireland to temporarily close **Devitt Villas, Glasthule** from the junction of Devitt Villas with Eden Road Lower to the junction of Devitt Villas with laneway to Adelaide Road from **Monday 28th October, 2019** to **Sunday 3rd November, 2019**.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate gas main alterations.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and the diversion routes will be signposted.

ROAD CLOSURES

SECTION 75, ROADS ACT, 1993 NOTICE OF INTENTION TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE OF M50 JUNCTIONS 14 TO 17

(Night Works)

14 to 17 Southbound

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, **on behalf of Transport Infrastructure Ireland,** gives notice in accordance with Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 that it has made an order to close

- The M50 **Southbound** between Junction 14 (Dún Laoghaire) and Junction 17 (M11 merge).
- The M50 Junction 15 **southbound** merge slip road
- The M50 Junction 16 **southbound** merge slip road

Dates of the closure:

Wednesday 25th September, 2019 – Friday 11th October, 2019.

Hours of closure: Monday – Sunday 10pm-6am

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate the resurfacing of the pavement.

On any given night, only one carriageway direction on the M50 shall be permitted to be closed and diverted.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and diversion routes clearly signposted, as agreed with Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council and An Garda Síochána. Local and emergency access will be allowed at all times.

Diversion of M50 mainline traffic will be via the N31 Leopardstown Road, R113 Leopardstown Road, N11 Dual Carriageway and M11.

Diversion of traffic wishing to travel on the M50 southbound from Junction 15 will be via Murphystown Way and Ballyogan Road to M50 Junction 14. Traffic will proceed along the N31 thereafter as above.

Diversion of traffic wishing to travel on the M50 southbound from Junction 16 will be via R118 Wyattville Road, N11 Dual Carriageway, and M11.

(Night Works)

14 to 17 Northbound

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, **on behalf of Transport Infrastructure Ireland,** gives notice in accordance with Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 that it has made an order to close:

- The M50 **Northbound** between Junction 17 (M11) and Junction 14 (Dún Laoghaire).
- The M50 Junction 16 **northbound** merge slip road
- The M50 Junction 15 **northbound** merge slip road

Dates of the closure:

Monday October 14th, 2019 – Friday November 8th, 2019

Hours of closure: Monday – Sunday 10pm-6am

The purpose of the closure is required to facilitate the resurfacing of the pavement.

On any given night, only one carriageway direction on the M50 shall be permitted to be closed and diverted.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and diversion routes clearly signposted, as agreed with Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council and An Garda Síochána. Local and emergency access will be allowed at all times.

Diversion of M50 mainline traffic will be via the M11, N11 Dual Carriageway, R113 Leopardstown Road and N31 Leopardstown Road.

Diversion of traffic wishing to travel on the M50 northbound from Junction 15 will be via Ballyogan Road and Murphystown Way.

Diversion of traffic wishing to travel on the M50 northbound from Junction 16 will be via R118 Wyattville Road, N11 Dual Carriageway, R113 Leopardstown Road and N31 Leopardstown Road.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 EXTENSION TO TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF TIVOLI ROAD AND CORRIG ROAD

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council Roads Maintenance Section have requested an extension to the temporary closure of **Tivoli Road and Corrig Road**, from the junction of Tivoli Road with York Road to the Junction of Corrig Road with Glenageary Road Lower up to and including **Friday 18th October, 2019.**

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times and diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The extension is primarily required by a combination of:

- Shallow brick culvert (Irish Water) to be lowered and design to be approved by Irish Water
- Poor condition of water connections along the whole length requiring substantial replacement and
- Fibre ducting to be installed.

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Closure of Tivoli Road and Corrig Road ***

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close **Tivoli Road and Corrig Road**, from the junction of Tivoli Road with York Road to the Junction of Corrig Road with Glenageary Road Lower from **6th August**, **2019** to **18th October 2019**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times and diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate road restoration and associated works.

Works will be undertaken between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs. (Monday to Saturday).

A Traffic Management Plan and signed detours will be in operation and local access will be maintained.

Traffic Management arrangements will remain in place over night for the duration of the works.

» Stillorgan Heath, Stillorgan ***

Trenching and ducting works will commence on Monday, 30th September 2019 until Friday, 4th October 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» St. Raphaela's Road, Stillorgan ***

Trenching and ducting works will commence on Monday, 30th September 2019 until Friday, 4th October 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» Anglesea Avenue, Blackroc k ***

Footpath restoration works will commence on Monday, 30th September 2019 until Friday, 11th October 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

Parking bays will be suspended on a phased basis as required.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times.

» George's Avenue, Blackrock ***

Cable jointing works will commence on Wednesday, 2nd October 2019 until Saturday, 5th October 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

(Night Works)

» Main Street, Blackrock ***

Drainage connection works will commence on Monday, 30th September 2019 until Thursday, 3rd October 2019 between 19:00 and 03:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Rosmeen Gardens / Granite Hall, Dún Laoghaire *

Snagging works will commence on Monday, 30th September 2019 until Friday, 4th October 2019 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times.

Enniskerry Road / Kilgobbin Road – Stepaside Garda Station ** (Night Works)

The Left Slip Lane coming from Enniskerry Road onto Kilgobbin Road, travelling from Sandyford will be closed from Monday, 23rd September 2019 until Friday, 4th October 2019 between 23:40 and 06:00 hrs.

A Diversion will be in place via Glenamuck Road.

Old Connaught Avenue/Dublin Road, Bray **

Works are being carried out on the Old Connaught Avenue / Dublin Road in Bray by GMC on behalf of Irish Water from Tuesday, 6th August until Friday, 11th October 2019.

The Contractor GMC will also carry out road restoration on behalf of DLRCC Roads Maintenance Section from Monday, 23rd September 2019.

There will be no access to Old Connaught Avenue from the Dublin Road.

A diversion is in place via Dargle Road, Fassaroe and Junction 5 North.

Kilmacud House / Kilmacud Road Upper ***

John Sisk & Son (Holding) Ltd. commenced the drainage works along Kilmacud Road Upper to service a new development at Kilmacud House on Monday, 2nd September 2019 until Friday, 4th October 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Public Lighting Lantern and Bracket Upgrade Works **

Public lighting lantern and bracket upgrade works will commence on: Monday, 16th September 2019 on:

- 1. Glenageary Road Lower
- 2. Killiney Road
- 3. Tivoli Road
- 4. Avondale Road
- 5. Ballinclea Road
- 6. Leopardstown Road
- 7. Glenageary Road upper
- 8. York Road
- 9. Vico Road
- 10. Sandyford Business Park

These works will continue until *Friday*, 20th December 2019.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation as required.

Nutgrove Avenue Improvement Works ***

Road Maintenance Section is carrying out road restoration / road surfacing works on Nutgrove Avenue in the coming months from the junction with Nutgrove Way to the Church of the Good Shepherd adjacent to Oakdown Road. In advance of this, minor works will be carried out along part of the route to improve cycling facilities at the junctions and along the route.

The outline programme of works is as follows:

- Cycle track improvement works from 9th September 2019 for 3-4 weeks. Hours of work - 10:00 to 16:00 hrs.
- Ground works/ Road Restoration works October to November Mainly night works.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for the duration of the works

Traffic lane restrictions or footway/cycle track restrictions may apply for each phase of the works.

Haigh Terrace and Lower George's Street, Dún Laoghaire ***

Clonmel Enterprise Ltd. have been appointed by Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council to undertake the Dún Laoghaire Upgrade Scheme along Haigh Terrace, Metals Walkway and Lower George's Street.

The works will commence on 2nd September 2019 and run for 16 consecutive weeks. When complete the project will create a significantly better environment and better pedestrian connection between the seafront and the town.

The works at Haigh Terrace commenced on 2nd September and undertaken on a phased basis with working hours restricted between 08:00 and 18:00hrs.

Clonmel Enterprises Ltd. will implement various Traffic Management Plans along Haigh Terrace with access along Haigh Terrace and the Maritime Museum maintained.

The on-street parking spaces along Haigh Terrace will be suspended for the duration of the works.

N11 Cabinteely (Closure of bus lane – Northbound and Southbound carriageways) ***

Works commenced on Tuesday, 26th February 2019 to construct a new signalized junction and construction of 135 m of new Druid's Glen Road until *December 2019*.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

N11 and N31 National Road Re-Signing Contract **

Work has commenced on the upgrade of traffic directional signage at various junctions along the N11 and N31. The project involves the removal and disposal of existing signage, construction/installation of new sign faces, sign face panels and patches, and new posts/supports and foundations at a number of locations.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for works on the N11 and N31. Traffic lane restrictions or footway/cycle track restrictions may apply for each phase of the works.

Brennanstown Road, Foxrock – new Residential Development ***

New footpath, traffic roundabout, road resurfacing and the installation of utility services commenced on Monday, 15th July 2019 until Friday, *15th November 2019* between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

N11 Cabinteely (Closure of North and Southbound bus lanes) ***

Closure of north and southbound bus lanes and restrictions on cycle lanes will continue in order to facilitate road widening works near both Circle K filling stations on N11, Cabinteely.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Windsor Terrace – Dún Laoghaire Baths Redevelopment **

Construction commenced on the redevelopment of the Baths site on Monday, 23rd April 2018. Construction is programmed to be completed by Q1 2020.

During **October**, pier rock armour will be completed. Internal construction of the building will continue with the upper level services / floors / walls being installed. Construction of the new sea walls and various other walls on the site will continue. There should be no Traffic Management restrictions on Windsor Terrace with the exception of the delivery of materials, which will be short term and between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. Monday – Friday.
