ROAD WORKS SPEED LIMIT ORDER

Road Works Speed Limit Order, No. 2 of 2019 on the N11 Dual Carriageway in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown

Notice is hereby given that Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004 in the interests of road safety and to facilitate the construction of the new signalised junction on the N11 at Cabinteely, south of the Johnstown Road junction, has made an Order entitled "Road Works Speed Limit Order, No.2 of 2019 on the **N11 Dual Carriageway** in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown" to apply a road works speed limit as follows:

The Special Speed Limit of 60 km/hr will be valid for the N11 Southbound and Northbound and will run from 07/10/2019 until 01/03/2020 or for the duration of the works whichever is the earlier.

The location of the special speed limit will be for part of the Southbound and Northbound carriageways of the N11 between a point 425 metres South of the existing junction of the N11 with Johnstown Road, to a point 1015 metres North of the R118 overbridge (at the junction of N11 / Wyattville Road). The length of road subject to this speed limit is 400m.

Road Works Speed Limit Order, No. 1 of 2019 on the M50 Motorway in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown

Notice is hereby given that Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004, in the interests of road safety and to facilitate the resurfacing of the M50 Motorway, has made an Order entitled:

Road Works Speed Limit Order, No.1 of 2019 on the M50 Motorway in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown to apply a road works speed limit as follows:

M50 Northbound:

will run from 23/09/2019 until 08/11/2019 or for the duration of the works whichever is the earlier.

Description of speed limit order 80km/hr:

 Part of the Northbound M50 between a point 335 metres South of the existing Crinken Lane over bridge to a point 165 metres North of the Crinken Lane overbridge (Total 500m in length).

Description of speed limit order 60km/hr:

- Part of the Northbound M50 between a point 165 metres North of the existing Crinken Lane overbridge to a point 300 metres West of the R113 overbridge (Total 8000m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 17 (M11 Junction 4) from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 70 metres North of the Lordello Road overbridge (Total 450m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 16 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 55 metres East of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 16 (Total 605m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 merge at Junction 16 from a point 80 metres West of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 16 to the end of the merge taper (Total 700m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 15 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 130 metres East of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 15 (Total 500m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 merge at Junction 15 from a point 35 metres North
 of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 15 to the end of the merge
 taper
 (Total 590m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 13 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 420 metres East of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 13 (Total 480m in length).

ROAD CLOSURES

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Closure of Roadways to facilitate the Dublin City Marathon 2019

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close the following roads within the Council's Administrative area:

- 1. Clonskeagh Road
- 2. Roebuck Road
- 3. Foster's Avenue
- 4. Stillorgan Road (R138 Dual Carriageway), north from junction with Foster's Avenue and via the UCD Flyover to the County Boundary.

The purpose of the closures is to facilitate the running of the **KBC Dublin Marathon** on **Sunday**, **27**th **October 2019**.

It is proposed that the roads, within the Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council Area will be temporarily closed from **9.30am to 4.00pm** to facilitate the race and to allow sufficient time for a clean-up before re-opening to traffic.

Manning of the Road Closures and the diversion of Traffic will be under the Control of the Gardaí and race organisers and will be clearly signposted. Local access will be maintained as fully as possible.

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Closure of Devitt Villas, Glasthule

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close **Devitt Villas, Glasthule** from the junction of Devitt Villas with Eden Road Lower to the junction of Devitt Villas with laneway to Adelaide Road from **Monday, 28**th **October 2019** to **Sunday, 3**rd **November 2019**.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate gas main alterations.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and the diversion routes will be signposted.

SECTION 75, ROADS ACT, 1993 NOTICE OF INTENTION TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE OF M50 JUNCTIONS 14 TO 17

(Night Works)

14 to 17 Northbound

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, **on behalf of Transport Infrastructure Ireland,** gives notice in accordance with Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 that it has made an order to close:

- The M50 **Northbound** between Junction 17 (M11) and Junction 14 (Dún Laoghaire).
- The M50 Junction 16 **northbound** merge slip road
- The M50 Junction 15 **northbound** merge slip road

Dates of the closure:

Monday October 14th, 2019 - Friday November 8th, 2019

Hours of closure:

Monday - Sunday 10pm-6am

The purpose of the closure is required to facilitate the resurfacing of the pavement.

On any given night, only one carriageway direction on the M50 shall be permitted to be closed and diverted.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and diversion routes clearly signposted, as agreed with Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council and An Garda Síochána. Local and emergency access will be allowed at all times.

Diversion of M50 mainline traffic will be via the M11, N11 Dual Carriageway, R113 Leopardstown Road and N31 Leopardstown Road.

Diversion of traffic wishing to travel on the M50 northbound from Junction 15 will be via Ballyogan Road and Murphystown Way.

Diversion of traffic wishing to travel on the M50 northbound from Junction 16 will be via R118 Wyattville Road, N11 Dual Carriageway, R113 Leopardstown Road and N31 Leopardstown Road.

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

» York Road / Tivoli Road Junction *** (Night Works)

Restoration works will commence on Monday night, 21st October 2019 until Friday, 25th October 2019 between 19:00 and 04:00 hrs. (Monday to Friday).

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times.

» Drummartin Link Road (Bridge over the LUAS Line) **

Site investigation works on behalf of ESB Networks will commence on Monday, 21st until Tuesday, 22nd October 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» Cunningham Drive, Dalkey **

Road restoration works will commence on Monday, 21st October 2019 until Friday, 1st November 2019 between 09:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

» Marley Court, Rathfarnham *

Footpath works will continue until Friday, 25th October 2019 between 08:00 and 17:00 hrs

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Nutgrove Avenue Improvement Works ***

(Night works)

Road Maintenance Section is carrying out road restoration / road surfacing works between the Junction of Nutgrove Way to Whitebarn Road.

Works will commence **nightly** from Sunday, 20th October 2019 until Wednesday, 23rd October 2019 between 19:00 and 06:00 hrs.

Road reconstruction works commenced on Monday, 7^{th} October 2019 <u>for 6 weeks</u> from 09:30 to 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for the duration of the works Lights will be turned Off at Meadow Park Avenue.

Stillorgan Heath, Stillorgan **

Trenching and ducting works on behalf of ESB Networks will continue until Friday, 25th October 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Anglesea Avenue, Blackrock ***

Footpath restoration works will continue until Friday, 25th October 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

Parking bays will be suspended on a phased basis as required.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times.

N11 Cabinteely (Closure of North and Southbound bus lanes) ***

(Night Works)

Closure of north and southbound bus lanes, and restrictions on cycle lanes will continue in order to facilitate road widening works near both Circle K filling stations on N11, Cabinteely.

Works in the Median will begin from 7th October and will continue for 3 months.

2 lanes in both directions will be maintained, and as the lanes will be narrowed, a Special Speed Limit of **60km/hr** will apply for the duration of the works in the median.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Public Lighting Lantern and Bracket Upgrade Works **

Public lighting lantern and bracket upgrade works will commence on: Monday, 16th September 2019 on:

- 1. Glenageary Road Lower
- 2. Killiney Road
- 3. Tivoli Road
- 4. Avondale Road
- 5. Ballinclea Road
- 6. Leopardstown Road
- 7. Glenageary Road upper
- 8. York Road
- 9. Vico Road
- 10. Sandyford Business Park

These works will continue until Friday, 20th December 2019.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation as required.

Haigh Terrace and Lower George's Street, Dún Laoghaire ***

Clonmel Enterprise Ltd. have been appointed by Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council to undertake the Dún Laoghaire Upgrade Scheme along Haigh Terrace, Metals Walkway and Lower George's Street.

The works will commence on 2nd September 2019 and run *for 16 consecutive weeks*. When complete the project will create a significantly better environment and better pedestrian connection between the seafront and the town.

The works at Haigh Terrace commenced on 2nd September and undertaken on a phased basis with working hours restricted between 08:00 and 18:00hrs.

Clonmel Enterprises Ltd. will implement various Traffic Management Plans along Haigh Terrace with access along Haigh Terrace and the Maritime Museum maintained.

The on-street parking spaces along Haigh Terrace will be suspended for the duration of the works.

N11 and N31 National Road Re-Signing Contract **

Work has commenced on the upgrade of traffic directional signage at various junctions along the N11 and N31. The project involves the removal and disposal of existing signage, construction/installation of new sign faces, sign face panels and patches, and new posts/supports and foundations at a number of locations.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation for works on the N11 and N31. Traffic lane restrictions or footway/cycle track restrictions may apply for each phase of the works.

Brennanstown Road, Foxrock - new Residential Development ***

New footpath, traffic roundabout, road resurfacing and the installation of utility services commenced on Monday, 15th July 2019 until Friday, 15th November 2019 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Windsor Terrace - Dún Laoghaire Baths Redevelopment **

Construction commenced on the redevelopment of the Baths site on Monday, 23rd April 2018. Construction is programmed to be completed by Q1 2020.

During **October**, pier rock armour will be completed. Internal construction of the building will continue with the upper level services / floors / walls being installed. Construction of the new sea walls and various other walls on the site will continue. There should be no Traffic Management restrictions on Windsor Terrace with the exception of the delivery of materials, which will be short term and between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. Monday – Friday.
