This note is not part of the Instrument and does not purport to be a legal interpretation:-

The purpose of these Regulations is to prescribe the form of application for a casual trading licence in accordance with section 4 of the Casual Trading Act, 1995.

Section 4(11) of the Casual Trading Act, 1995, provides that the Local Authority concerned shall notify the Minister for Social Welfare of the name and address of a person to whom a casual trading licence was granted and the conditions of the licence and Section 4(2A) of the Casual Trading Act, 1995 (inserted by section 141 of the Finance Act, 1996 (No. 9 of 1966) provides that the Local Authority concerned shall notify the Revenue Commissioners of the name, address and tax reference number of a person to whom a casual trading licence was granted and the conditions of the licence.

Section 13 of the Casual Trading Act, 1995, also provides that a Local Authority may establish and maintain the Register of Casual Trading Licences on computer. In such circumstances personal data kept in the Register is subject to the requirements of the Data Protection Act, 1988 (No. 25 of 1988) including an individual's right of access to and verification of data, where appropriate.
