

NOTICE OF THE CONFIRMATION OF A COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 76 OF AND THE THIRD SCHEDULE TO THE HOUSING ACT, 1966, AND ALL ACTS AMENDING AND EXTENDING THE SAME, SECTION 10 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT (NO. 2) ACT, 1960 AND ALL ACTS AMENDING AND EXTENDING THE SAME (AS SUBSTITUTED BY SECTION 86 OF THE HOUSING ACT, 1966), AS RESPECTS ALL OR PART OF THE LAND TO WHICH THE COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER RELATES TO BE PUBLISHED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 78 (1) OF THE HOUSING ACT, 1966, AS AMENDED BY THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACTS, 2000-2015 AND ALL ACTS AMENDING AND EXTENDING THE SAME.

COMPULSORY ACQUISITION OF LAND

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council Compulsory Purchase (M 50 Junction 14 link Road) Order, 2016

An Bord Pleanála has on the 6th day of April 2017, made a Confirmation Order confirming the above-named Compulsory Purchase Order as respects the land described in the Schedule hereto. The said Order, as so confirmed, authorises The County Council of the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown to acquire the said land compulsorily. A copy of the Order as so confirmed and of the map referred to in it may be seen at the Offices of: -

- Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, Property Management Section, Level 3, Infrastructure and Climate Change, County Hall, Marine Road, Dún Laoghaire, Co. Dublin between the hours of 9.30 a.m. – 1.00 p.m. and 2.15 p.m. – 5.00 p.m. on normal working days and 4.30 p.m. on Fridays.
- Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council offices at Dundrum Office Park, Main Street, Dundrum, Co. Dublin between the hours of 9.30a.m. - 12.30 p.m. and 1.30 p.m. – 4.30 p.m. - Monday to Friday.

The Order, as so confirmed, will become operative at the expiration of three weeks after the date of publication of this Notice, but if an application for Judicial Review of the decision of the Council under Order 84 of the Rules of the Superior Courts (S.I. No. 15 of 1986) is duly made to the High Court within eight weeks of the date of publication of this Notice in accordance with Section 50 of the Planning and Development Acts, (2000 - 2015), and all acts amending and extending the same and as substituted by Section 13 of the Planning and Development (Strategic Infrastructure) Act, 2006, the Court –

- A. May by interim order suspend the operation of the Compulsory Purchase Order as so confirmed either generally or in so far only as it affects any property of the applicant until the final determination of the proceedings.
- B. If satisfied upon the hearing of the application that the Compulsory Purchase Order as so confirmed is not within the powers of the Housing Act, 1966, as extended by Section 10 of the Local Government (No.2) Act, 1960 (as substituted by Section 86 of the Housing Act, 1966) or that the interests of the applicant have been substantially prejudiced by any requirement of the Act, not having been complied with, may quash the Order as so confirmed either generally or in so far as it affects any property of the applicant.


Schedule – Part II
