The new round of LEADER funding will have three THEMES:

1. Economic Development, Enterprise Development and Job Creation;

Sub-themes: Rural Tourism, Enterprise Development, Rural Towns.

2. Social Inclusion;

Sub-themes: Basic Services targeted at Hard to Reach Communities, Rural Youth

A. Rural Environment;

Sub-themes: Protection & Sustainable Use of Water Resources, Protection & Improvement of Local Biodiversity, Development of Renewable Energy.

In the new round of LEADER funding there will be two avenues for applying for funding:

- 1) As with previous programmes; applications can be dealt with on a ‘rolling call’ of (first come first served) basis.
- 2) Targeted Call which will involve opening and closing dates for submission of Expression of Interest forms. These calls will be widely publicised in advance and funding will be awarded to successful applicants following a comparative assessment of all applications received.
