SPEED LIMIT ORDER

Road Works Speed Limit Order, No. 1 of 2023 on the N11 in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown

Notice is hereby given that Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004, in the interests of road safety and to facilitate the resurfacing of the N11 motorway has made an Order entitled **Road Works Speed Limit Order, No.1 of 2023 on the N11 motorway in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown to apply a road works speed limit as follows:**

N11 Southbound and Northbound will run from 2nd May 2023 until 30th June 2023

- Part of the N11 between its junction with Kill Lane (Foxrock Church) to 100m South of its junction with Clonkeen Road.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF KERRYMOUNT AVENUE

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GLASTHULE ROAD, DÚN LAOGHAIRE

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Glasthule and Sandycove Traders Association aka also known as GS Business Group for the temporary closure of Glasthule Road from Adelaide Road junction at the lights on Glasthule Road between 64 Wine and The Greedy Eagle to Glasthule Road above Q Cleaners on **Friday 16th June, 2023** from **07:00 hours to 19:00 hours**.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate the Bloomsday Festival 2023.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. The diversion routes will be signposted.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MAIN STREET, DUNDRUM

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an order to temporarily close Main Street, Dundrum between its junction with Kilmacud Road Upper to just south of the entrance to the Village Centre Carpark. The closure is to take place from **13:00 hours to 18:00 hours** on **Sunday, 25th June 2023**.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate the Dundrum Arts & Cultural Festival.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and all diversions will be signposted. Pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BALLYMAN ROAD, ENNISKERRY

The purpose of the closure is to lay new section of pipe as part of the Old Connaught Woodbrook contract between the junction of Thornhill Road up to Dún Laoghaire Golf Club on Ballyman Road

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BALLYMAN LANE, KILTERNAN

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Ward and Burke Construction to temporarily close Ballyman Lane, Kiltarnan from Murphy's Lane to Ballyman Lane from **Friday, 26th May 2023 to Friday, 24th November 2023**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure relates to the watermains works on Ballyman Road which will be coming up to the junction of Ballyman Lane to lay pipe there. There will also be a large number of concrete and construction equipment deliveries before then using Ballyman Lane.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THORNHILL ROAD, OLD CONNAUGHT, BRAY

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Ward and Burke Construction to temporarily close Thornhill Road, Old Connaught, Bray from entrance of St. Gerard's Catholic School to Wicklow County Council Border from **Wednesday, 28th June 2023 to Friday, 6th October 2023**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to lay new watermains as part of the Old Connaught Woodbrook contract on behalf of Uisce Éireann.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MEADOW MOUNT AND MEADOW GROVE

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close Meadow Mount and a section of Meadow Grove, Ballinteer. The closure is to take place from **18:30 hours to 21:30 hours** on **Wednesday, 21st June 2023**.

The purpose of the proposed closure is to facilitate the Stephen Roche GP Cycle Race.

Diversion of traffic will be via Barton Road East, Meadow Avenue, Meadow Grove, Willow Road and Beech Lawn and vice versa.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and the diversion routes will be signposted.

Emergency Access can be provided, if required, during the period of the road closure.

TRAFFIC LIGHTS

Carysfort Avenue - Junction with Stillorgan Park and Fleurville

The traffic signal sequence at the junction of Carysfort Avenue /Fleurville/ Stillorgan Park Rd has been changed. This is a trial sequence to improve safety at the junction. Delays are expected as the timings are recalibrated.

Traffic Management will be in place at various locations along Blackglen Road, Lamb's Cross junction and the junction of Harold's Grange Road and College Road.

Myrtle Square/Convent Lane *

Convent Lane closed to traffic from George's Street. Access only to St. Michael's Hospital, Primary Diversion Library Road and Wellington Street.

Deliveries and Local Access to Convent Lane via Convent Road, Banksman in place to assist deliveries. Deliveries/Emergency access only between 8pm-10am.

Ballinteer Road, Ballinteer **

Ongoing works on wall at Dundrum Wood have ceased for the moment. However, a new footpath layout has been implemented. This will be maintained until the issues with a dangerous wall are resolved.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.
