**PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURES**

**SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993**  
**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ST. JOHN'S PARK, DÚN LAOGHAIRE**

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council proposes to temporarily close St. John's Park, Dún Laoghaire from its junction with Mounttown Road Upper to end of cul-de-sac from **Monday, 17<sup>th</sup> July 2023 to Friday, 18<sup>th</sup> August 2023**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is required to facilitate the safe undertaking of full depth road restoration up to 0.40m depth and associated footpath and kerb restoration works as part of DLR Road Maintenance 2023 Works Programme.

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from GMC Utilities – Uisce Éireann to temporarily close Monkstown Farm, Monkstown from Monkstown Avenue to Oliver Plunkett Road from **Monday, 10<sup>th</sup> July 2023** to **Saturday, 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2023**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is a water and sewer connection are to be installed at this location.

**ROAD CLOSURES**

**SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993**  
**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF KERRYMOUNT AVENUE, FOXROCK**

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from WA November Productions DAC to temporarily close Kerrymount Avenue, Foxrock from the junction with Brighton Road to the junction with Claremont Road (roundabout) from Monday, **3<sup>rd</sup> July 2023** to Tuesday, **4<sup>th</sup> July 2023** between 19:00 hours (3<sup>rd</sup> July) to 06:00 hours (4<sup>th</sup> July).

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate night-time filming for a feature film. There will be crew members and equipment on the road, and action vehicles driving on the road. Three streetlights requested to be switched off. Genie booms x2 parked on the street.

**SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993**  
**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GLENAGEARY ROAD UPPER**

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Roadstone Ltd to temporarily close Glenageary Road Upper from the junction of R829 Sallynoggin Roundabout to the junction of Killiney Roundabout from **Monday, 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2023** to **Thursday, 29<sup>th</sup> February 2024**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. It is not a full road closure - the road will remain open to eastbound motorised traffic.

The scheduling of the works has been changed to maximise works near Rathdown School during school holidays. One of the diversion routes is a distributor road without frontage development. Other diversion routes already have traffic calming. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The Roads Maintenance Section produced a report showing that the proposed works method is the best to minimise traffic impact.

The purpose of the closure is full road reconstruction works will require the road to be excavated with associated ancillary works on the footpath.

**SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993**  
**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THORNHILL ROAD, OLD CONNAUGHT, BRAY**

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Ward and Burke Construction to temporarily close Thornhill Road, Old Connaught, Bray from entrance of St. Gerard's Catholic School to Wicklow County Council Border from **Wednesday, 28<sup>th</sup> June 2023** to **Friday, 6<sup>th</sup> October 2023**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to lay new watermains as part of the Old Connaught Woodbrook contract on behalf of Uisce Éireann.

**SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993**  
**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BALLYMAN LANE, KILTERNAN**

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Ward and Burke Construction to temporarily close Ballyman Lane, Kiltiernan from Murphy's Lane to Ballyman Lane until **Friday, 24<sup>th</sup> November 2023**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure relates to the watermains works on Ballyman Road which will be coming up to the junction of Ballyman Lane to lay pipe there. There will also be a large number of concrete and construction equipment deliveries before then using Ballyman Lane.

## ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

### » **Glenageary Road Upper – Travel Active Scheme \*\*\*** (Sometimes Night Works)

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, in conjunction with the National Transport Authority, has planned Active Travel Improvement Scheme on Glenageary Road Upper between the Sallynoggin and Killiney Towers Roundabouts.

This Scheme consists of restoration of existing carriageway, construction of two-way cycle track facility on the north side, new toucan crossings, full road construction and associated drainage/ducting/landscaping/and other ancillary works.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place on **Monday, 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2023** until **Friday, 28<sup>th</sup> July 2023** from Glenageary Park Junction to Adelaide Road Junction between the hours of 08:00 to 18:00, night times between the hours of 19:00 to 05:00 will be allowed, if required.

Local access will be maintained at all times.

### » **Thornhill Road, Mount Merrion \*\***

A 2-Way Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» **Watson Road, Killiney \*\***

TLI Group will be carrying out cabling works, on behalf of ESB Networks, for a residential development on Watson Road.

Works will commence on Monday, 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2023 and Tuesday, 4<sup>th</sup> July 2023.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

# **Rock Road – from Trimleston Avenue to Booterstown Avenue \*\*\***  
(Sometimes Night Works)

Finishing works such as landscaping, traffic signals, line marking, and all associated works to construct a two-way cycle track will continue until Friday, 7<sup>th</sup> July 2023.

Works will take place between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. inbound and 08:00 to 18:00 outbound.

# **Ballymoss Road and Arkle Road, Sandyford Business District \*\***

Pedestrian and Cycle Improvement Scheme will continue until Friday, 7<sup>th</sup> July 2023 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

# **Ballyogan Avenue \*\***

Works on a new raised zebra crossing will continue until Friday, 7<sup>th</sup> July 2023 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A 2-Way Traffic Management Plan and 3-Way Stop/Go system will be in place.

# **Cork Little, Woodbrook \*\*\***

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are carrying out upgrade works to the water network programme. Works commenced on Monday, 29<sup>th</sup> May 2023 and will continue until Friday, 14<sup>th</sup> July 2023 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A 2-Way Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are carrying out pressure management to the water and sewerage network.

### Rockville, Carrickmines \*\*

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are carrying out upgrade to the water network programme. Works will continue until Tuesday, 11<sup>th</sup> July 2023 between 09:00 and 18:00 hours.

A 3-Way Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

### Corrig Road – Sandyford Business District \*\*

Works on bituminous entrances and concrete footpaths will continue until Friday, 14<sup>th</sup> July 2023 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

### Quinn's Road, Shankill \*

Essential beach access repair work is scheduled to take place at the end of Quinn's Road will continue until Friday, 14<sup>th</sup> July 2023 between 07:00 and 17:00 hrs.

A small quantity of construction traffic will be traversing the route from the rail bridge near Corbawn Drive and travelling to the construction site at the beach front located at the end of Quinn's Road.

Construction traffic will also travel through the Shanganagh Cliffs Parks area.

The traffic will be marshalled through Corbawn Drive and Shanganagh Cliffs Parks area.

### **Wyattville Road Cycle Scheme \*\*\***

Provision of footpaths, cycleways, junction buildouts, new kerbing, and all associated works will continue until Friday, 21<sup>st</sup> July 2023. Works will take place between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. The location for the works is Wyattville Road between Church Road and Churchview Road, including the associated junctions.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

### **Ballyman Lane, Kilternan \***

Road closure on Ballyman Lane in order to facilitate Pipeline Works installation, on behalf of Irish Water will continue until Friday, 24<sup>th</sup> November 2023 on a 24-hour schedule.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

### **Blackglen Road Improvement Scheme \*\*\***

Works are ongoing at this location.

Traffic Management will be in place at various locations along Blackglen Road, Lamb's Cross junction and the junction of Harold's Grange Road and College Road.

### **Clonskeagh Road Cycle Scheme \*\*\***

Works suspended until further notice. Actavo Ltd. will perform ongoing maintenance of existing traffic management measures in place.

### **Ballinteer Road, Ballinteer \*\***

Ongoing works on wall at Dundrum Wood have ceased for the moment. However, a new footpath layout has been implemented. This will be maintained until the issues with a dangerous wall are resolved.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

### **Myrtle Square/Convent Lane \***

Convent Lane closed to traffic from George's Street. Access only to St. Michael's Hospital, Primary Diversion Library Road and Wellington Street.

Deliveries and Local Access to Convent Lane via Convent Road, Banksman in place to assist deliveries. Deliveries/Emergency access only between 8pm-10am.
