SPEED LIMIT ORDER

**Road Works Speed Limit Order, No. 1 of 2023 on the N11
in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown**

Notice is hereby given that Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004, in the interests of road safety and to facilitate the resurfacing of the N11 motorway has made an Order entitled **Road Works Speed Limit Order, No.1 of 2023 on the N11 motorway in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown to apply a road works speed limit as follows:**

N11 Southbound and Northbound will run from 2nd May 2023 until 30th June 2023

Description of speed limit order **60km/hr:**

- Part of the N11 between its junction with Kill Lane (Foxrock Church) to 100m South of its junction with Clonkeen Road.

PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURES

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ST. JOHN'S PARK, DÚN LAOGHAIRE

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council proposes to temporarily close St. John's Park, Dún Laoghaire from its junction with Mounttown Road Upper to end of cul-de-sac from **Monday, 17th July 2023** to **Friday, 18th August 2023**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is required to facilitate the safe undertaking of full depth road restoration up to 0.40m depth and associated footpath and kerb restoration works as part of DLR Road Maintenance 2023 Works Programme.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY AMENDED CLOSURE OF KERRYMOUNT AVENUE, FOXROCK

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an amended application from WA November Productions DAC to temporarily close Kerrymount Avenue, Foxrock from the junction with Brighton Road to the junction with Claremont Road (roundabout) from Monday, 3rd July 2023 to Tuesday, 4th July 2023 between 19:00 hours (3rd July) to 06:00 hours (4th July).

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate night-time filming for a feature film. There will be crew members and equipment on the road, and action vehicles driving on the road. Three streetlights requested to be switched off. Genie booms x2 parked on the street.

ROAD CLOSURES

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BALLYMAN ROAD, ENNISKERRY

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Ward and Burke Construction Ltd. to extend the road closure at Ballyman Road from Thornhill Road junction to Dún Laoghaire Golf Club. The closure will now run until **Tuesday, 27th June 2023**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to lay new section of pipe as part of the Old Connaught Woodbrook contract between the junction of Thornhill Road up to Dún Laoghaire Golf Club on Ballyman Road.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BALLYMAN LANE, KILTERNAN

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Ward and Burke Construction to temporarily close Ballyman Lane, Kiltarnan from Murphy's Lane to Ballyman Lane until **Friday, 24th November 2023**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure relates to the watermains works on Ballyman Road which will be coming up to the junction of Ballyman Lane to lay pipe there. There will also be a large number of concrete and construction equipment deliveries before then using Ballyman Lane.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT. 1993 Temporary Closure of Glenageary Road Upper

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Roadstone Ltd to temporarily close Glenageary Road Upper from the junction of R829 Sallynoggin Roundabout to the junction of Killiney Roundabout from **Monday, 3rd July 2023 to Thursday, 29th February 2024**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. It is not a full road closure - the road will remain open to eastbound motorised traffic.

The scheduling of the works has been changed to maximise works near Rathdown School during school holidays. One of the diversion routes is a

distributor road without frontage development. Other diversion routes already have traffic calming. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The Roads Maintenance Section produced a report showing that the proposed works method is the best to minimise traffic impact.

The purpose of the closure is full road reconstruction works will require the road to be excavated with associated ancillary works on the footpath.

**SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MAIN STREET, DUNDRUM**

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an order to temporarily close Main Street, Dundrum between its junction with Kilmacud Road Upper to just south of the entrance to the Village Centre Carpark. The closure is to take place from **13:00 hours to 18:00 hours** on **Sunday, 25th June 2023**.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate the Dundrum Arts & Cultural Festival.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and all diversions will be signposted. Pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times.

**SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THORNHILL ROAD, OLD CONNAUGHT, BRAY**

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Ward and Burke Construction to temporarily close Thornhill Road, Old Connaught, Bray from entrance of St. Gerard's Catholic School to Wicklow County Council Border from **Wednesday, 28th June 2023** to **Friday, 6th October 2023**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to lay new watermains as part of the Old Connaught Woodbrook contract on behalf of Uisce Éireann.

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

» **Braemor Road, Churchtown**

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are laying water mains and undertaking rehab works on Braemor Road at the junctions with Hillside Drive, Riverside Drive and Woodside Drive.

Works will run from Monday 26th June 2023 to Friday, 30th June 2023 between 08:00 and 18:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» **Churchtown Road Upper- junction with Braemor Road*****

Virgin Media will be reinstating a concrete footpath at this location on Tuesday 27th June 2023.

Works will take place between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Stop/Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» **Glenageary Road Upper- from Sallynoggin Roundabout to Killiney Roundabout (Night works)**

Roadstone Ltd, on behalf of the Council's Active Travel section, will be undertaking a CCTV survey of the existing drainage pipes in this area. The works will take place from Sunday 25th June 2023 to Friday 30th June 2023 between 19:30 and 06:00 hours. These works are in anticipation of the provision of an Active Travel scheme in this area.

A Stop/Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» **Junction of Glenageary Road Upper & Glenageary Park**

Roadstone Ltd, on behalf of the Council's Active Travel section, will be undertaking civil works at this location from Monday 26th June 2023 to Friday 30th June 2023 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours. These works are in anticipation of the provision of an Active Travel scheme in this area.

A Stop/Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» **Maples Road, Wedgewood, Sandyford ****

Works on a new raised pedestrian crossing have commenced and will continue until Friday, 30th June 2023 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A 2-Way Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» **Orwell Road at junction with Eaton Brae ***

Drainage and concrete footpath works will commence on Wednesday, 28th June 2023 for one week. Works will take place between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan with a 3 way Stop & Go system will be in place.

Ballyman Road ***

Road closure on Ballyman Road in order to facilitate Pipeline Works installation, on behalf of Irish Water will continue until Friday, 30th June 2023 on a 24-hour schedule.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Ballyogan Avenue **

Works on a new raised zebra crossing will continue until Friday, 30th June 2023 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A 2-Way Traffic Management Plan and 3-Way Stop/Go system will be in place.

Cherrywood Park **

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are carrying out pressure management to the water and sewerage network.

Works will continue until Friday, 30th June 2023 between 08:00 and 18:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Corrig Road – Sandyford Business District **

Works on bituminous entrances and concrete footpaths will continue until Friday 14th July 2023 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Grange Wood, Ballinteer **

MCM Surfacing Ltd., on behalf of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council will continue with utility raisings concrete until Friday, 30th June 2023 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

Access will be restricted for pedestrians and vehicular traffic during the works.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation.

Hillside Drive, Braemor Road, Churchtown **

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are undertaking the laying of water mains and rehab works at this location.

Works will continue until Friday, 30th June 2023 between 08:00 and 18:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Landscape Crescent (Braemor Road) *

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are laying water mains and undertaking rehab works.

N11 Stillorgan - Lower Kilmacud Road to Bray Road ***

Inbound / Outbound

(Night works)

Resetting iron works, HFS and relining road markings will continue until Friday, 30th June 2023 between 19:30 and 06:00 hours.

The N11 Inbound lane and the adjacent footpath and cycle tracks will be closed to accommodate these works. The lane closures will be in operation from Leopardstown Road to Lower Kilmacud Road.

Orwell Road / Thorncliffe Park, Rathgar **

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are laying water mains and undertaking rehab works.

Works will continue until Friday, 30th June 2023 between 08:00 and 18:00 hours.

Rock Road – from Trimleston Avenue to Booterstown Avenue ***
(Sometimes Night Works)

Finishing works such as landscaping, traffic signals, line marking, and all associated works to construct a two-way cycle track will continue until Friday, 7th July 2023.

Works will take place between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. inbound and 08:00 to 18:00 outbound.

Rockville, Carrickmines **

GMC Utilities working on behalf of Irish Water are carrying out upgrade to the water network programme. Works will continue until Friday, 23rd June 2023 between 09:00 and 18:00 hours.

A 3-Way Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Woodside Drive, Braemor Road, Churchtown **

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are undertaking the laying of water mains and undertaking rehab works at this location.

Works will continue until Friday, 30th June 2023 between 08:00 and 18:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Wyattville Road Cycle Scheme ***

Ballymoss Road and Arkle Road, Sandyford Business District **

Pedestrian and Cycle Improvement Scheme will continue until Friday, 30th June 2023 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Blackglen Road Improvement Scheme ***

Works are ongoing at this location.

Traffic Management will be in place at various locations along Blackglen Road, Lamb's Cross junction and the junction of Harold's Grange Road and College Road.

Cork Little, Woodbrook ***

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are carrying out upgrade works to the water and sewerage network. Works commenced on Monday, 29th May 2023 and will continue until Friday, 30th June 2023 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A 2-Way Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Clonskeagh Road Cycle Scheme ***

Works suspended until further notice. Actavo Ltd. will perform ongoing maintenance of existing traffic management measures in place.

Myrtle Square/Convent Lane *

Convent Lane closed to traffic from George's Street. Access only to St. Michael's Hospital, Primary Diversion Library Road and Wellington Street.

Deliveries and Local Access to Convent Lane via Convent Road, Banksman in place to assist deliveries. Deliveries/Emergency access only between 8pm-10am.

Quinn's Road, Shankill *

Essential beach access repair work is scheduled to take place at the end of Quinn's Road will continue until Friday, 14th July 2023 between 07:00 and 17:00 hrs.

A small quantity of construction traffic will be traversing the route from the rail bridge near Corbawn Drive and travelling to the construction site at the beach front located at the end of Quinn's Road.

Construction traffic will also travel through the Shanganagh Cliffs Parks area.

The traffic will be marshalled through Corbawn Drive and Shanganagh Cliffs Parks area.
