SPEED LIMIT ORDER

Road Works Speed Limit Order, No. 1 of 2023 on the N11 in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown

Notice is hereby given that Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004, in the interests of road safety and to facilitate the resurfacing of the N11 motorway has made an Order entitled Road Works Speed Limit Order, No.1 of 2023 on the N11 motorway in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown to apply a road works speed limit as follows:

N11 Southbound and Northbound will run from 2nd May 2023 until 30th June 2023

 Part of the N11 between its junction with Kill Lane (Foxrock Church) to 100m South of its junction with Clonkeen Road.

PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURES

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GLENAGEARY ROAD UPPER

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from Roadstone Ltd. to temporarily close Glenageary Road Upper from the junction of R829 Sallynoggin Roundabout to the junction of Killiney Roundabout from **Monday, 3rd July 2023** to **Thursday, 29th February 2024**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is full road reconstruction works will require the road to be excavated with associated ancillary works on the footpath.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF VICTORIA ROAD, KILLINEY

Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council has received an application from David Maher and Associates, Structural Engineers, on behalf of DLR Architects Dept. to temporarily close Victoria Road from its junction with Killiney Hill Road to its junction with Vico Road.

It is proposed that Victoria Road will be closed from **05.00hrs to 12.00hrs** on **Sunday, 18th June 2023**. The purpose of the closure is to survey an existing damaged archway which has been impacted by several heavy goods vehicles. This inspection will determine the structural integrity of the arch and inform the remedial measures required to repair and make safe the structure.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation. Local access will be maintained at all times.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MEADOW MOUNT AND MEADOW GROVE

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from Orwell Wheelers to temporarily close Meadow Mount and a section of Meadow Grove, Ballinteer. The proposed closure is to take place from **18:30 hours to 21.30 hours** on **Wednesday, 21st June 2023**.

The purpose of the proposed closure is to facilitate the Stephen Roche GP Cycle Race.

Diversion of traffic will be via Barton Road East, Meadow Avenue, Meadow Grove, Willow Road and Beech Lawn and vice versa.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BALLYMAN LANE, KILTERNAN

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Ward and Burke Construction to temporarily close Ballyman Lane, Kilternan from Murphy's Lane to Ballyman Lane from **Friday**, **26**th **May 2023** to **Friday**, **24**th **November 2023**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure relates to the watermains works on Ballyman Road which will be coming up to the junction of Ballyman Lane to lay pipe there. There will also be a large number of concrete and construction equipment deliveries before then using Ballyman Lane.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MAIN STREET, DUNDRUM

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an order to temporarily close Main Street, Dundrum between its junction with Kilmacud Road Upper to just south of the entrance to the Village Centre Carpark. The closure is to take place from **13:00 hours to 18:00 hours** on **Sunday, 25th June 2023**.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate the Dundrum Arts & Cultural Festival.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and all diversions will be signposted. Pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BALLYMAN ROAD, ENNISKERRY

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Ward and Burke Construction Ltd. to extend the road closure at Ballyman Road from Thornhill Road junction to Dún Laoghaire Golf Club to **Tuesday, 27th June 2023**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to lay new section of pipe as part of the Old Connaught Woodbrook contract between the junction of Thornhill Road up to Dún Laoghaire Golf Club on Ballyman Road

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CASTLE STREET, DALKEY

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Discover Dalkey Promotions Ltd. to temporarily close Castle Street, Dalkey from Church of the Assumption car park / The Queen's Bar to the former Allied Irish Bank / Maxwell's Pharmacy on **Monday**, **5**th **June 2023** from **11:00 hours to 19:00 hours**.

A Traffic Management Plan with diversion routes will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate safe parking and display of vintage cars as part of the Dalkey Vintage Festival.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THORNHILL ROAD, OLD CONNAUGHT, BRAY

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Ward and Burke Construction to temporarily close Thornhill Road, Old Connaught, Bray from entrance of St. Gerard's Catholic School to Wicklow County Council Border from **Wednesday**, **28**th **June 2023** to **Friday**, **6**th **October 2023**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to lay new watermains as part of the Old Connaught Woodbrook contract on behalf of Uisce Éireann.

TRAFFIC LIGHTS

Carysfort Avenue - Junction with Stillorgan Park and Fleurville

The traffic signal sequence at the junction of Carysfort Avenue /Fleurville/ Stillorgan Park Rd has been changed. This is a trial sequence to improve safety at the junction. Delays are expected as the timings are recalibrated.

Resurfacing road, resetting iron works, HFS and relining road markings will continue until Friday, 23rd June 2023 between 19:30 and 06:00 hours.

The N11 Outbound lane and the adjacent footpath and cycle tracks will be closed to accommodate these works. The lane closures will be in operation from Stillorgan Grove to Kill Lane.
