## Key road measures and traffic flow



Living Streets Dún Laoghaire is a new scheme involving sustainable mobility and public realm improvements. It aims to make our local streets safer and greener, our communities more connected, and to keep our economy vibrant. This illustration explains its main road measures and traffic flow implications.

- There are three modal filters proposed for this project, a modal filter is a design feature at a single point in a road that prevents vehicles passing but allows pedestrians and cyclists to pass through. Modal filters are designed to stop through-traffic, and to create safer, greener streets.

- The project aims to maintain and facilitate destination traffic.
- All main routes into town remain open.
- All car parks remain open.
- The movement and access of emergency service vehicles will be facilitated within pedestrianised area throughout the day as required.
- Change in direction on Windsor Terrace from Link Road to allow people to drive all the way along the coast from Glashule to Blackrock.
