PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURE

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MARETIMO TERRACE, BLACKROCK

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received a Temporary Road Closure application from Townmore Construction, Clonminch Park, Tullamore, Co. Offaly proposing to temporarily close Maretimo Terrace, Blackrock, Co. Dublin from its junction with N31 to its junction with Newtown Villas from **Saturday, 18th November 2023 to Sunday, 19th November 2023.**

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to install a mobile crane so a tower crane can be removed.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF TRAFALGAR TERRACE AND BELGRAVE PLACE, SEAPOINT, MONKSTOWN

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application to temporarily close all Trafalgar Terrace and part of Belgrave Place from its junction with Trafalgar Lane to its junction with Trafalgar Terrace on **Monday, 23rd October 2023** to **Friday, 27th October 2023** between 08:00 hours to 18:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate road resurfacing works.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF N11 between its Junction with Kill Lane (Foxrock Church) to on ramp R118 Cherrywood Interchange - Southbound and Northbound

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Roadstone, Fortunestown, Belgard, Tallaght, Dublin 24 to temporarily close part of the N11 Stillorgan Road between its junction with Kill Lane (Foxrock Church) to on ramp R118 Cherrywood Interchange junction southbound and northbound from **Monday, 18th September 2023** to **Thursday, 30th November 2023** between 19:30 hours to 05:00 hours each day.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian, local access and access for bus and emergency services will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to widen lanes one and two.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993
Road Works Speed Limit Order, No. 2 of 2023 on the N11 in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown

Notice is hereby given that Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004, in the interests of road safety and to facilitate the resurfacing of the N11 motorway has made an Order entitled **Road Works Speed Limit Order, No.2 of 2023 on the N11 motorway in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown to apply a road works speed limit as follows:**

N11 Southbound and Northbound will run from 18/09/2023 until 30/11/2023

Description of speed limit order **60km/hr:**

- Part of the N11 between its junction with Kill Lane (Foxrock Church) to on ramp R118 Cherrywood Interchange junction southbound and northbound.

The Garda Commissioner has been notified by email of the Council's intention to decrease the speed limit to 60 km/hr and 60 km on the N11 Southbound and Northbound, in accordance with Section 10 of the Roads Traffic Act, 2004.

Accordingly, I recommend the introduction of the 60 km/hr speed limit (N11 Southbound and Northbound) from Monday 18th September 2023 until Thursday 30th November 2023 or for the duration of the works, whichever is the earlier.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BALLYMAN LANE, KILTERNAN

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Ward and Burke Construction to temporarily close Ballyman Lane, Kiltiernan from Murphy's Lane to Ballyman Lane until **Friday, 24th November 2023**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure relates to the watermains works on Ballyman Road which will be coming up to the junction of Ballyman Lane to lay pipe there. There will also be a large number of concrete and construction equipment deliveries before then using Ballyman Lane.

**SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GLENAGEARY ROAD UPPER**

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Roadstone Ltd. to temporarily close Glenageary Road Upper from the junction of R829 Sallynoggin Roundabout to the junction of Killiney Roundabout from **Monday, 3rd July 2023 to Thursday, 29th February 2024.**

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. It is not a full road closure - the road will remain open to eastbound motorised traffic.

The scheduling of the works has been changed to maximise works near Rathdown School during school holidays. One of the diversion routes is a distributor road without frontage development. Other diversion routes already have traffic calming. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The Roads Maintenance Section produced a report showing that the proposed works method is the best to minimise traffic impact.

The purpose of the closure is full road reconstruction works will require the road to be excavated with associated ancillary works on the footpath.

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

» **Woodbrook Shanganagh Wastewater Network Extension Works
(UISCE ÉIREANN) *****

Wastewater system improvement works are being carried out by GMC on behalf of Uisce Éireann in Shanganagh Cliffs, Corbawn Avenue, Corbawn Drive, Quinn's Road and Shanganah Park.

Works commenced on the 10th of August 2023 and will last for a duration of approximately 50 weeks including the works off road in Shanganagh Park.

A traffic management system will be in place Monday – Friday.

Deansgrange Cycle Route Scheme ***

Circet (Ireland) Ltd., working on behalf of DLRCC, are working to provide a two-way cycle track on the western side of Deansgrange Road. The works will also upgrade pedestrian and cyclist's facilities along Kill Lane between the entrance to Clonkeen Park and the junction with Deansgrange Road.

There will be no northbound access to Deansgrange Road from Clonkeen Road / Kill Lane until approximately March 2024. Southbound access will remain open via a new temporary one-way system south of St. Fintan's Villas. Diversion signs will be in place. Traffic management measures will be in place along Deansgrange Road to facilitate the works.

The 84 and 84A northbound bus services will be diverted via Abbey Road for the duration of the works. The southbound bus route remains the same.

During Mid Term break until 3 November works will take place on Kill Lane outside the entrance to the school / church. Works involve widening and reinstating the cycle facilities.
