

Section 75 of the Roads Act 1993
Temporary Closure of Nutgrove Park, Roebuck

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from GMC Utilities that proposes the temporary closure of Nutgrove Park, Roebuck from its junction with Leinster Lawn to its junction with Clonskeagh Road from Wednesday 10th July, 2024 to Friday 19th July, 2024.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is for the installation of a new joint box on the existing 110kv ESB line going through Nutgrove Park.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MEADOW MOUNT AND MEADOW GROVE

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from Orwell Wheelers to temporarily close Meadow Mount and a section of Meadow Grove, Ballinteer. The proposed closure is to take place from 18:30 hours to 21.30 hours on **Wednesday, 26th June 2024**.

The purpose of the proposed closure is to facilitate the Stephen Roche GP Cycle Race.

Diversion of traffic will be via Barton Road East, Meadow Avenue, Meadow Grove, Willow Road and Beech Lawn and vice versa.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and the diversion routes will be signposted.

Emergency Access can be provided, if required, during the period of the road closure.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF R138 STILLORGAN ROAD

Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council has approved an application to temporarily close R138/Stillorgan Road from Fosters Avenue to Belfield Bridge on **Sunday 2nd June, 2024** from 11.30 hours to 16.00 hours in order to facilitate the running of the VHI Women's Mini Marathon.

The diversion route is via Foster's Avenue and Roebuck Road.

The purpose of the proposed closure is to replace/repair telecom units.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CASTLE STREET, DALKEY

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Discover Dalkey Promotions Ltd. to temporarily close Castle Street, Dalkey from Church of the Assumption car park / The Queen's Bar to the former Allied Irish Bank / Maxwell's Pharmacy on **Monday, 3rd June 2024** from 11:00 hours to 19:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan with diversion routes will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate safe parking and display of vintage cars as part of the Dalkey Vintage Festival.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CASTLE STREET, DALKEY

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Discover Dalkey Promotions Ltd to temporarily close Castle Street, Dalkey from Church of the Assumption car park / The Queen's Bar to the former Allied Irish Bank / Maxwell's pharmacy. The closure will take place from **Saturday 15th June, 2024 until Sunday 16th June, 2024** from 11:00 hours to 19:00 hours each day.

A Traffic Management Plan with diversion routes will be in operation. Pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate a street festival run in conjunction with Dalkey Book Festival. The absence of traffic will bring a festival atmosphere for community and visitors.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GLENAGEARY ROAD UPPER

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Roadstone Ltd to extend the temporary closure of Glenageary Road Upper from the junction of R829 Sallynoggin Roundabout to the junction of Killiney Roundabout to **Saturday, 15th June 2024**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times.

It is not a full road closure - the road will remain open to eastbound motorised traffic. The scheduling of the works has been changed to maximise works near Rathdown School during school holidays. One of the diversion routes is a distributor road without frontage development. Other diversion routes already have traffic calming. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted. The Roads Maintenance Section produced a report showing that the proposed works method is the best to minimise traffic impact.

The purpose of the closure is full road reconstruction works will require the road to be excavated and associated ancillary works on footpath.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BALLYMAN ROAD**

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council approved an application from Ward and Burke Construction Ltd. to temporarily close Ballyman Road from Thornhill Road junction to Dún Laoghaire Golf Club from **Thursday, 23rd May 2024 to Wednesday, 5th June 2024.**

Closure will only commence when works on Ferndale Road have been completed.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is for the permanent reinstatement of road surfaces in this area.

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Ward and Burke Construction Ltd. to temporarily close Ballyman Lane, Kiltarnan from Murphy's Lane junction to Ballyman Lane from **Thursday, 6th June 2024 to Friday, 7th June 2024.**

Closure will only commence when works on Ferndale Road have been completed.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is for the permanent reinstatement of road surfaces in this area.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FERNDALE ROAD**

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Ward and Burke Construction to temporarily close Ferndale Road from Thornhill Road / Old Connaught Avenue junction to Allies River Road junction from **Monday, 22nd April 2024 to Friday, 21st June 2024.**

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate the installation of a culvert replacement for Uisce Éireann.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF N11 BETWEEN ITS JUNCTION WITH KILL
LANE
(FOXROCK CHURCH) TO ON RAMP R118 CHERRYWOOD INTERCHANGE
SOUTHBOUND AND NORTHBOUND

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Roadstone, Fortunestown, Belgard, Tallaght, Dublin 24 to temporarily close part of the N11 Stillorgan Road between its junction with Kill Lane (Foxrock Church) to on ramp R118 Cherrywood Interchange junction southbound and northbound from **Monday, 22nd January 2024** to **Sunday, 30th June 2024** between 19:30 hours to 05:00 hours each day.

The start time of 19:30hrs is required as it allows the Contractor sufficient time to carry out the section of the works that creates the most noise i.e. the planing of the existing road surface.

It is a requirement that this section of the works is completed by 23:00hrs, therefore commencing the works at a time past 19:30hrs would serve to severely limit production and have a detrimental effect of the programme of the overall works.

An earlier time than 19:30hrs would assist with the programme, but the effect on traffic movements would not be manageable. Therefore a 19:30hrs start time provides the best approach in balancing both traffic movements and ensuring progress of the works.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian, local access and access for bus and emergency services will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to allow for realignment of the traffic lanes.

Road Works Speed Limit Order, No.1 of 2024 on the N11 Roadway in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown

Southbound: from 22/01/2024 to 30/06/2024 or until the end of the works, whichever is the earlier.

Northbound: from 22/01/2024 to 30/06/2024 or until the end of the works, whichever is the earlier.

Notice is hereby given that Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004, in the interests of road safety and to facilitate the resurfacing of the N11 motorway has made an Order entitled **Road Works Speed Limit Order, No.1 of 2024 on the N11 motorway in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown to apply a road works speed limit as follows:**

N11 Southbound and Northbound will run from 22/01/2024 until 30/06/2024

Description of speed limit order **60km/hr:**

- Part of the N11 between its junction with Kill Lane (Foxrock Church) to on ramp R118 Cherrywood Interchange junction southbound and northbound.

The Garda Commissioner has been notified by email of the Council's intention to decrease the speed limit to 60km/hr on the N11 Southbound and Northbound, in accordance with Section 10 of the Roads Traffic Act, 2004.

Accordingly, I recommend the introduction of the 60km/hr speed limit (N11 Southbound and Northbound) from Monday, 22nd January 2024 until Sunday, 30th June 2024 or for the duration of the works, whichever is the earlier.
