PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURES

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE OF CASTLE STREET, DALKEY

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from Discover Dalkey Promotions Ltd. to temporarily close Castle Street, Dalkey from Church of the Assumption car park / The Queen's Bar to the former Allied Irish Bank / Maxwell's pharmacy from Saturday, 24th August 2024 until Sunday, 25th August 2024 from 11:00 hours to 19:00 hours each day.

A Traffic Management Plan with diversion routes will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times.

The purpose of the closure is to create a safe and family friendly community atmosphere for the Lobster Festival with cookery demonstrations, street entertainment etc.

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from Swarco UK & Ireland Ltd. that proposes the temporary closure of (1) M50 Southbound between Junction 14 and Junction 15, (2) M/N11 merge onto M50 Southbound, (3) M50 Southbound between Junction 15 and Junction 16. The closure is proposed to run from Monday, 15th July 2024 to Wednesday, 17th July 2024 between 22:00 hours and 05:00 hours each night.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the proposed closure is to facilitate the installation of CCTV poles on behalf of Transport Infrastructure Ireland.

Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Closure of Brennanstown Road

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application for the temporary road closure of Brennanstown Road from its junction with Brighton Road to its junction with Cabinteely Village crossroads (Garda Station) from **Monday 15th July 2024** to **Friday, 6th September 2024** between the times of 08:00 hours and 18:00 hours each day.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the proposed closure is for road reconstruction and resurfacing and footpath resurfacing.

ROAD CLOSURES

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF NUTGROVE PARK, ROEBUCK

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from GMC Utilities that proposes the temporary closure of Nutgrove Park, Roebuck from its junction with Leinster Lawn to its junction with Clonskeagh Road from **Wednesday**, **10**th **July 2024** to **Friday**, **19**th **July 2024**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is for the installation of a new joint box on the existing 110kv ESB line going through Nutgrove Park.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MAIN STREET, DUNDRUM

Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council has approved an order to temporarily close Main Street, Dundrum between its junction with Kilmacud Road Upper to just south of the entrance to the Village Centre Carpark. The closure is to take place from 13:00 hours to 18:00 hours on **Sunday, 30th June 2024**.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate the Dundrum Arts & Cultural Festival.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and all diversions will be signposted. Pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF N11 BETWEEN ITS JUNCTIONS WITH KILL LANE (FOXROCK CHURCH) TO ON RAMP R118 CHERRYWOOD INTERCHANGE SOUTHBOUND AND NORTHBOUND

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Roadstone, Fortunestown, Belgard, Tallaght, Dublin 24 to temporarily close part of the N11 Stillorgan Road between its junction with Kill Lane (Foxrock Church) to on ramp R118 Cherrywood Interchange junction southbound and northbound from **Monday**, **22**nd **January 2024** to **Sunday**, **30**th **June 2024** between 19:30 hours to 05:00 hours each day.

The start time of 19:30hrs is required as it allows the Contractor sufficient time to carry out the section of the works that creates the most noise i.e. the planing of the existing road surface.

It is a requirement that this section of the works is completed by 23:00hrs, therefore commencing the works at a time past 19:30hrs would serve to severely limit production and have a detrimental effect of the programme of the overall works.

An earlier time than 19:30hrs would assist with the programme, but the effect on traffic movements would not be manageable. Therefore a 19:30hrs start time provides the best approach in balancing both traffic movements and ensuring progress of the works.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian, local access and access for bus and emergency services will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to allow for realignment of the traffic lanes.

Road Works Speed Limit Order, No. 1 of 2024 on the N11 Roadway in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown

Southbound: from 22/01/2024 to 30/06/2024 or until the end of the works, whichever is the earlier.

Northbound: from 22/01/2024 to 30/06/2024 or until the end of the works, whichever is the earlier.

Notice is hereby given that Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004, in the interests of road safety and to facilitate the resurfacing of the N11 motorway has made an Order entitled Road Works Speed Limit Order, No.1 of 2024 on the N11 motorway in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown to apply a road works speed limit as follows:

N11 Southbound and Northbound will run from 22/01/2024 until 30/06/2024

Description of speed limit order 60km/hr:

• Part of the N11 between its junction with Kill Lane (Foxrock Church) to on ramp R118 Cherrywood Interchange junction southbound and northbound.

The Garda Commissioner has been notified by email of the Council's intention to decrease the speed limit to 60km/hr on the N11 Southbound and Northbound, in accordance with Section 10 of the Roads Traffic Act, 2004.

Accordingly, I recommend the introduction of the 60km/hr speed limit (N11 Southbound and Northbound) from Monday, 22nd January 2024 until <u>Sunday</u>, 30th June 2024 or for the duration of the works, whichever is the earlier.

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS


LEHAUNSTOWN LANE

» Druid's Glen Road, Phase 2

Upon the completion of the Druid's Glen Road Phase 2 scheme, Lehaunstown Lane will no longer be a through road from Brennanstown Road direction except for cyclists and pedestrians.

As a result, vehicles wishing to travel towards Laughanstown Luas stop direction from Brennanstown Road will need to follow the new route along Brennanstown Road, Johnstown Road, N11 south bound and via the new junction at N11 onto the Druid's Glen Road, as shown by the **blue arrows** on the map below. Local access to the first 160m section of Lehaunstown Lane from Brennanstown Road will be maintained.

This modal filter arrangement, approved as part of the Cherrywood Planning Scheme, came into operation on 27th June 2024.



» Ballyogan Vale, Carrickmines **

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, will be undertaking upgrade works to the water and sewage network.

Works will take place from Monday 1st July 2024 to Friday 5th July 2024.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place with a single lane closure and a 2 way Stop/Go system.

» Foxrock Avenue, Foxrock **

Works to replace a pole in front of house on Foxrock Avenue will take place on Monday 1st July 2024 for one day between 09:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» Foxrock Close, Foxrock **

Works to replace a pole in front of house on Foxrock Close will take place on Tuesday 2nd July 2024 for one day between 09:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» Foxrock Park, Foxrock **

Works to replace a pole in front of house on Foxrock Avenue will take place on Wednesday, 3rd July 2024 for one day between 09:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» Kill Lane- between junctions with Foxrock Court & Foxrock Park

Works on the link poles and on the clearance of footpath blockages will commence on Monday 1^{st} July 2024 and run until Friday 5^{th} July 2024.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

It may be necessary to partly close the bus lane in order to allow for pedestrian access.

» Northumberland Avenue **

Footpath reinstatement works will commence on Monday, 1st July 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours for a period of 6-8 weeks.

Some extra hours are possible.

Avondale Road, Killiney **

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are carrying out upgrade to the water and sewer network programme at this location. Works will continue until Tuesday, 2nd July 2024 between 10:00 and 18:00 hours.

A 2-Way Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Blackthorn Road **

Roadway/footpath reinstatement works will continue until Friday, 26th July 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Church Road, Killiney **

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are carrying out upgrade to the water and sewer network programme at this location. Works will continue until Friday, 5th July 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A 2-Way Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Deerpark Entrance, North Avenue, Mount Merrion **

Improvement works to the Deerpark entrance on North Avenue will continue until Friday 5th July 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Drummartin Road, Dundrum **

GMC Utilities Group Ltd. are carrying out cable extraction, joint bay installation works until Friday, 5th July 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Eden Park Road **

GMC Utilities Group Ltd. are working on the exposure of existing ESB HV cable joints. Work will continue until Friday, 5^{th} July 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Goatstown Road, Goatstown **

GMC Utilities Group Ltd. are carrying out cable extraction, joint bay installation works until Friday, 5th July 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

Goatstown Road and Larchfield Road ***

GMC Utilities Group Ltd. are working on the exposure of existing ESB HV cable joints. Work will continue until Friday, 5^{th} July 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

Harbour Road and Breffni Road **

Roadway/footpath reinstatement works will continue until Friday, 12th July 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

Clonmel Enterprises, working on behalf of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, are undertaking civil works as part of the Druid Glen Road Construction until Friday, 28th July 2024 between 08:00 and 18:00 hours.

Maple Road, Clonskeagh **

GMC Utilities Group Ltd. are carrying out cable extraction, joint bay installation works on until Friday, 5^{th} July 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

Stillorgan Village, Blackrock **

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are carrying out rehab/reinstatement works to the water and sewer network programme at this location. Works will continue until Friday, 5th July 2024 between 08:00 and 18:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Blackglen Road Improvement Scheme ***

Works are ongoing at this location.

Traffic Management will be in place at various locations along Blackglen Road, Lamb's Cross junction and the junction of Harold's Grange Road and College Road.

Deansgrange Cycle Route Scheme ***

Circet (Ireland) Ltd., working on behalf of DLRCC, are upgrading pedestrian and cycling facilities along Kill Lane between the entrance to Clonkeen Park and the junction with Deansgrange Road. This will facilitate better access to the new two-way cycle facility on Deansgrange Road. The works involve protection measures for utilities, new kerbs, new drainage, upgrade of traffic signal infrastructure and junction road resurfacing. The works are scheduled to continue until Friday, 5th July 2024.

Glenageary Road Upper - Active Travel Scheme ***

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, in conjunction with the National Transport Authority, has planned an Active Travel Improvement Scheme on Glenageary Road Upper between the Sallynoggin and Killiney Towers Roundabouts.

This scheme consists of restoration of existing carriageway, construction of two-way cycle track facility on the north side, new toucan crossings, full road construction and associated drainage/ducting/landscaping/and other ancillary works.

Local access will be maintained at all times.
