#### PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURES

# SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF VICTORIA ROAD AND VICO ROAD, KILLINEY

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from Carew Construction Ltd. that proposes the temporary closure of Victoria Road and Vico Road, Killiney from the intersection of Victoria Road/Killiney Hill Road to the intersection of Vico Road/Coliemore Road on **Thursday**, **8**<sup>th</sup> **August 2024** and **Thursday**, **29**<sup>th</sup> **August 2024** between 08:00 hours to 17:00 hours each day.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times.

The purpose of the closure is repair works to the Camelot Arch on Victoria Road.

# SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GLENAGEARY ROAD UPPER

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from Roadstone Ltd. that proposes the temporary closure of Glenageary Road Upper from the junction of R829 Sallynoggin Roundabout to the junction of Killiney Roundabout from Monday, 29<sup>th</sup> July 2024 to Monday, 30<sup>th</sup> September 2024.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. <u>It is not a full road closure</u> - the road will remain open to eastbound motorised traffic. The scheduling of the works has been changed to maximise works near Rathdown School during school holidays. One of the diversion routes is a distributor road without frontage development. Other division routes already have traffic calming. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted. The Roads Maintenance Section produced a report showing that the proposed works method is the best to minimise traffic impact.

The purpose of the closure is road resurfacing works will require the final layer of asphalt and minor civil works including ironworks, line marking and installation of defender kerbs.

# **SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT. 1993 Temporary Closure of Castle Street, Dalkey**

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Discover Dalkey Promotions Ltd to temporarily close Castle Street, Dalkey from Church of the Assumption car park / The Queen's Bar to the former Allied Irish Bank / Maxwell's pharmacy from Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> August, 2024 until Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> August, 2024 from 11:00 hours to 19:00 hours each day.

A Traffic Management Plan with diversion routes will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times.

The purpose of the closure is to create a safe and family friendly community atmosphere for the Lobster Festival with cookery demonstrations, street entertainment etc.

# Section 75 of the Roads Act, 1993 Temporary Closure of Brennanstown Road

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application for the temporary road closure of Brennanstown Road from its junction with Brighton Road to its junction with Cabinteely Village crossroads (Garda Station) from **Monday, 15<sup>th</sup> July 2024** to **Friday, 6<sup>th</sup> September 2024** between the times of 08:00 hours and 18:00 hours each day.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is for road reconstruction and resurfacing and footpath resurfacing.

#### » KYLEMORE HOUSE, CHURCH ROAD, KILLINEY, DUBLIN CC\*\*

GMC Utilities working on behalf of Irish Water are carrying out upgrade to the water& sewer network programme.

Works will commence on Thursday, 25<sup>th</sup> July 2024 for one day between the 09.00 and 16.00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan with be in place, with a two way stop and go system.

#### » Foxrock Avenue \*\*

Forming New Vehicular Apron For Access to Foxrock Ave.

Works will be commence on Tuesday, 6<sup>th</sup> August 2024 to Friday, 9<sup>th</sup> August 2024 between the 09.00 and 16.00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

#### » Beech Park Road \*\*

Replace pole on Beech Park Road in front of house and repair aerial minor works in front of house.

Works will commence on Thursday, 25<sup>th</sup> July 2024 for one day between 09:00 and 16:00 hours.

#### » Meadowvale \*\*

Replace pole on Meadow Vale across from houses and at the verge/park and minor aerial works on nearby poles.

Works will commence on Wednesday, 24<sup>th</sup> July 2024 for one day between 09:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

#### » Meadowvale \*\*

Replace poles on Meadow Vale in front of houses and in concrete sidewalk, and minor aerial works on nearby poles.

Works will commence on Tuesday, 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2024 for one day between 09:00 and 16:00 hours.

## » Maple Road, Clonskeagh \*\*

Joint bay installation works will continue from Monday, 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2024 until Friday, 26<sup>th</sup> July 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

## » Drummartin Road, Dundrum \*\*

Joint bay installation works will continue from Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> July to Friday, 26<sup>th</sup> July 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

# » Cornelscourt Hill Road Junction with Old Bray Road, Cabinteely \*\*\* (Night works)

Roadway resurfacing works will commence on Monday, 15<sup>th</sup> July 2024 at night between 19:00 and 05:00 hours for 8-nights (Monday to Thursday).

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and lights will be switched out for the duration of these works.

#### » Westminster Road, Foxrock \*\*

Footpath reinstatement and drainage works will commence on Wednesday, 17<sup>th</sup> July 2024 until Wednesday, 24<sup>th</sup> July 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

# Newtownpark Avenue between Granville Road and Whites Cross, Blackrock \*\*\* (Night works)

Gas Networks Ireland are replacing valves on existing Gas Mains located in the carriageway. These works commenced on Monday, 8<sup>th</sup> July 2024 and will continue until Friday, 26<sup>th</sup> July 2024.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place - 24/7.

#### # Frankfort / Rosemount Junction, Dundrum Road \*\*

Construction of signalised junction will continue until Friday, 26<sup>th</sup> July 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A 4-Way Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

## # Deerpark Entrance, North Avenue, Mount Merrion \*\*

Improvement works to the Deerpark entrance on North Avenue will continue until Friday 16<sup>th</sup> August 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

#### # Pearse Drive, Sallynoggin \*\*

Footpath and road improvements will continue until Friday, 26<sup>th</sup> July 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

#### # Blackthorn Road \*\*

Roadway/footpath reinstatement works will continue until Friday, 26<sup>th</sup> July 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

#### Northumberland Avenue \*\*

Roadway/footpath reinstatement works commenced on Monday,  $1^{st}$  July 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours for a period of <u>6-8 weeks</u>.

Some extra hours are possible.

#### **Blackglen Road Improvement Scheme \*\*\***

Works are ongoing at this location.

Traffic Management will be in place at various locations along Blackglen Road, Lamb's Cross junction and the junction of Harold's Grange Road and College Road.

#### **#** Deansgrange Cycle Route Scheme \*\*

Circet (Ireland) Ltd., working on behalf of DLRCC, are upgrading pedestrian and cycling facilities along Kill Lane between the entrance to Clonkeen Park and the junction with Deansgrange Road. The scheme is now substantially complete, but some minor snagging works may take place during July. The works will have a low impact on traffic.

## Glenageary Road Upper - Active Travel Scheme \*\*\*

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, in conjunction with the National Transport Authority, has planned an Active Travel Improvement Scheme on Glenageary Road Upper between the Sallynoggin and Killiney Towers Roundabouts.

This scheme consists of restoration of existing carriageway, construction of twoway cycle track facility on the north side, new toucan crossings, full road construction and associated drainage/ducting/landscaping/and other ancillary works.

Local access will be maintained at all times.
