PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURES

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ROADWAYS TO FACILITATE THE DUBLIN CITY MARATHON

The Irish Life Dublin City Marathon will take place on **Sunday, 27th October 2024**. The following roads within the Councils Administrative area will be subject to partial closure or full closure:

1. Clonskeagh Road
2. Roebuck Road
3. Foster's Avenue
4. Stillorgan Road (R138 Dual Carriageway), North from junction with Foster's Avenue and via the UCD Flyover to the Dublin City County Boundary.

Manning of the Road Closures and the diversion of Traffic will be under the Control of the Gardaí and race organisers and diversions will be clearly signposted. Local access will be maintained as far as possible.

ROAD CLOSURES

Section 75 of the Roads Act 1993 Temporary Closure of Glenamuck Road, Carrickmines

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Uisce Éireann – GMC Utilities for the temporary closure of Glenamuck Road, Carrickmines from its junction with Cairnbrook to its junction with The View from **Tuesday 29th October 2024** to **Sunday 3rd November 2024**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to install a sewer connection.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT. 1993 Temporary Closure of Puck's Castle Lane

Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Secto Services Ltd to temporarily close Puck's Castle Lane, Rathmichael from its junction with Ballycorus Road to its junction with Quarry Road. The proposed closure will run from **Monday, 11th November 2024** to **Friday, 15th November 2024** between 09:30 hours and 16:15 hours each day.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to install ducting for broadband on behalf of National Broadband Ireland (NBI).

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THORNHILL ROAD

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from DM Morris Ltd. to temporary close Thornhill Road, Old Connaught, Bray from entrance of St. Gerard's Catholic School to Old Conna from **Monday, 28th October 2024** to **Friday, 1st November 2024**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to repair and reconstruct the road surface

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

» **Dundela Park & Elton Park, Sandycove *****

Road resurfacing works will take place from Tuesday, 29th October 2024 until Friday, 1st November 2024 between 08:00 and 18:00 hours.

A Stop/Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» **Enniskerry Road, Kilternan *****

The footpath between Glenamuck Road and the Topaz Service Station will be closed from Tuesday, 29th October 2024 until Tuesday 5th November 2024. This is to facilitate hedge and tree removal works, the demolition of a gable wall and entrance footpath works.

Works will take place between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Stop/Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» **Enniskerry Road, Kilternan ****

Resurfacing works have commenced on the section of Enniskerry Road between the Grange Growers Garden Centre and the Ski Club of Ireland. Works will continue until Friday, 8th November 2024.

Works will take place between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Stop/Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» **Glenamuck Road, Kilternan ****

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are carrying out upgrade to the water and sewer network programme at this location.

Works will take place from Tuesday, 29th October 2024 to Friday, 1st November 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

Traffic management will consist of a 2-Way Stop /Go system and a single lane closure.

» **Grove Avenue, Blackrock ****

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are carrying out upgrade to the water and sewer network programme at this location.

Works will take place from Tuesday, 29th October 2024 to Friday, 1st November 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A 2-Way Stop /Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» **Meadowmount, Churchtown ***

Footpath and road resurfacing works will take place between Tuesday 29th October 2024 and Friday 8th November 2024. Works are scheduled between 08:00 and 19:00 hours.

A Stop/Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place. Access may be restricted in order to enable works to take place.

» **Newtownpark Avenue, Blackrock ****

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are carrying out upgrade to the water and sewer network programme at this location.

Works will continue until Friday, 1st November 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A 2-Way Stop /Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Blackglen Road, Sandyford **

Roadway/footpath reinstatement works will continue until Friday, 1st November 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Cross Avenue, Blackrock **

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are carrying out upgrade to the water and sewer network programme at this location.

Works will continue until Friday, 1st November 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A 2-Way Stop /Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Deerpark Entrance, North Avenue, Mount Merrion **

Improvement works to the Deerpark entrance on North Avenue will continue until Friday, 1st November 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Drummartin Road, Dundrum **

Cable pulling and cable jointing works will continue until Friday, 1st November 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Granville Road, Blackrock **

Roadway/footpath reinstatement works will continue until Friday, 1st November 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Goatstown Road, Goatstown **

Cable pulling and cable jointing works will continue until Friday, 1st November 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Highland Grove, The Park, Cabinteely **

Footpath repairs and reconstruction works will continue until 8th November 2024. Works will take place between 08:00 and 18:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan for cyclists/pedestrians will be in place.

Hyde Road / Ulverton Place Junction **

Excavation works on the footpath of the junction for new proposed Telecoms pole will continue until Friday, 1st November 2024 between 08:00 and 18:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Maple Road, Clonskeagh **

Cable jointing works will continue until Friday, 1st November 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

N11 UCD Flyover, Belfield ***

Cycle lane insulation works will continue until Friday 29th November 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

The works consist of construction of a segregated cycle track, road resurfacing, road markings, provision of cycle signals and adjustment to the existing traffic signal arrangement. Minor civil works such as ducting and changes to existing kerbs and footways will also take place.

Nighttime works will be required to enable resurfacing works and line marking.

Nighttime works are scheduled to commence mid-November 2024.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Newtownpark Avenue / Brooklawn Avenue, Blackrock **

Pedestrian crossing and surface water pipe works will continue until Friday, 1st November 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Northumberland Avenue, Dún Laoghaire **

Roadway/footpath reinstatement works will continue until Friday, 1st November 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Nutgrove Park, Clonskeagh **

Cable jointing works will continue until Friday, 1st November 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Pearse Drive, Sallynoggin **

Footpath and road improvements will continue until Friday, 1st November 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Roebuck Road, Clonskeagh **

Cable pulling and cable jointing works will continue until Friday, 1st November 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Rollins Villas, Sallynoggin **

Works on traffic calming measures (ramps, buildouts etc) has commenced and is scheduled to conclude in the middle of November 2024.

Works will take place between 08:00 and 18:00 hours.

A 2-Way Stop/Go traffic management system will be in place.

Stillorgan Park, Blackrock **

Footpath Upgrade works will continue until Friday 8th November 2024 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Blackglen Road Improvement Scheme **

Works are ongoing at this location.

Traffic Management will be in place at various locations along Blackglen Road, Lamb's Cross junction and the junction of Harold's Grange Road and College Road.

Cherrywood Business Park **

Clonmel Enterprises, working on behalf of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, are undertaking civils works as part of the Cherrywood Pond 5A Scheme.

Works will continue until Friday, 20th December 2024 between 08:00 and 18:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Glenageary Road Upper – Active Travel Scheme ***

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, in conjunction with the National Transport Authority, has planned an Active Travel Improvement Scheme on Glenageary Road Upper between the Sallynoggin and Killiney Towers Roundabouts.

This scheme consists of restoration of existing carriageway, construction of two-way cycle track facility on the north side, new toucan crossings, full road construction and associated drainage/ducting/landscaping/and other ancillary works.

Local access will be maintained at all times.
