ROAD CLOSURE

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MILITARY ROAD, BALLYBRACK

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Ballybrack Business Association to temporarily close Military Road, Ballybrack from its junction at Firgrove to its junction at Church Road on Sunday, 8th December 2024 from 14:00 hours to 18:00 hours.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate Christmas in the Village Community event.

A Traffic Management Plan with diversion routes will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times.

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

» Nerano Road, Dalkey outside Triton Lodge ***

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are carrying out upgrade to the water and sewer network programme at this location.
