PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURE

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF KILLINEY HILL ROAD

N11 - UCD Flyover, Belfield *** (Night Works)

Night-time works will take place from Monday, 13th January 2025 until Thursday, 16th January 2025 to enable resurfacing works and line marking.

The works will include the following: construction of a segregated cycle track, road resurfacing, road markings, provision of cycle signals and adjustment to the existing traffic signal arrangement. Minor civil works such as ducting and changes to existing kerbs and footways will also take place.

Night-time works may be required to enable resurfacing works and line marking.
