PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURE

Section 75 of the Roads Act 1993 Temporary Closure of Barnhill Road, Dalkey

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from Gas Networks Ireland requesting the temporary closure of Barnhill Road, Dalkey from its junction with Dalkey Court to its junction with Hyde Road. The proposed road closure will take place from Monday 3rd February, 2025 to Friday 7th February, 2025.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the proposed closure is for gas works.

» Anastasia Lane, Dalkey ***

» Beech Park Road, Foxrock***

The works consist of construction of a segregated cycle track, road resurfacing, road markings, provision of cycle signals and adjustment to the existing traffic signal arrangement. Minor civil works such as ducting and changes to existing kerbs and footways will also take place.

Nighttime works may be required to enable resurfacing works and line marking.
