PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURES

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BRIGHTON ROAD, FOXROCK

Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council has received an application from Donnelly Civil Engineering for the temporary road closure of Brighton Road from its junction with Brighton Wood to its junction with Hollybrook from **Monday, 14th April 2025** to **Sunday, 27th April 2025**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is for installation of sewer pipe for Beckett Woods development.

ROAD CLOSURES

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF WINDSOR TERRACE AND QUEEN'S ROAD, DÚN LAOGHAIRE

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Dún Laoghaire Business Association for the temporary closure of Windsor Terrace and Queen's Road, Dún Laoghaire from Islington Avenue junction to Marine Road junction on **Monday 17th March 2025** between 07:00 hours and 13:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is for a St. Patrick's Day parade.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ROCK HILL AND MAIN STREET, BLACKROCK

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Blackrock Business Association for the temporary closure of Rock Hill and Main Street, Blackrock from Poulet Bonne Femme to Carysfort Avenue junction on **Monday, 17th March 2025** between 11:00 hours and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is for St. Patrick's Day festival events.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ENNISKERRY ROAD, STEPASIDE

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Stepside Business Association for the temporary closure of Enniskerry Road, Stepside from the junction of Rosemount School and Fernhill Park through Stepside Village to the junction with Glenamuck Road South on **Monday, 17th March 2025** between 14:00 hours and 18:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate a St. Patrick's Day parade and associated events in Stepside Village.

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

» **Claremont Pines (Cul de Sac), Carrickmines ****

Proposed drainage and kerbing works will commence on Monday, 3rd March 2025 until Thursday, 6th March 2025 between 08:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» **Claremont Pines (Cul de Sac), Carrickmines ****

Proposed patching works will commence on Friday, 7th March 2025 for one day, between 08:00 and 17:00 hours.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» **Junction of Woodbrook Avenue and Dublin Road ****

Closure of footpath and redirection to opposite footpath and closure of cycleway to allow construction of permanent footpath and cycleway to front of housing development.

Works will commence on Monday, 3rd March 2025 until Friday, 7th March 2025 and from Monday, 10th March 2025 until Friday, 14th March 2025 between 07:30 and 16:30 daily.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» **Arbourfield Terrace, Dundrum ****

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are carrying out water upgrades at this location.

Works will take place on Wednesday, 5th March 2025 for one day, between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A 2-Way Stop /Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» **The Bridge, Enniskerry Road, Kilternan ****

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are carrying out sewer connection at this location.

Works will take place on Thursday, 6th March 2025 and Friday, 7th March 2025 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A 3-Way Stop /Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Deer Park entrance, North Avenue, Mount Merrion **

Improvement of Deer Park entrance on North Avenue will commence on Monday, 3rd March 2025 until Friday, 7th March 2025 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Blackglen Road, Sandyford **

Roadway/footpath reinstatement works will commence on Monday, 3rd March 2025 until Friday, 7th March 2025 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Granville Road off Churchview Road, Ballybrack **

Roadway/footpath reinstatement works will commence on Monday, 3rd March 2025 until Friday, 7th March 2025 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Ballycorus Road, Kiltarnan **

Boundary wall construction works commenced on Monday, 17th February 2025 and will continue until Friday, 14th March 2025 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Enniskerry Road, Enniskerry ** **(Night Works)**

New junction construction for the Glenamuck Distributor Road commenced on Monday, 17th February 2025 and will continue until Friday, 18th April 2025 – 24 hours.

Vehicle actuated traffic signals 7pm – 7am.

Manned Stop / Go 7am – 7pm.

Dún Laoghaire Central Active Travel Scheme ***

Baker's Corner, Kill Avenue, Kill Lane, Abbey Road, Rochestown Ave

Works shall continue at Bakers Corner junction and impact traffic flows along all approaches - Kill Avenue, Kill Lane, Abbey Road, Rochestown Avenue. The Bakers Corner phase of the works will last until April 2025. A Traffic Management Plan will be in place to minimise disruption with VM signs to give advance warning of the works. Intermittent Stop / Go Traffic Management can be expected between the hours of 10:00 to 16:00 - Monday to Friday.
