SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SILCHESTER ROAD, GLENAGEARY

Dún Laoghaire Central Active Travel Scheme ***

Baker's Corner, Kill Avenue, Kill Lane, Abbey Road, Rochestown Ave

Works shall continue at Bakers Corner junction and impact traffic flows along all approaches - Kill Avenue, Kill Lane, Abbey Road, Rochestown Avenue. Works at Bakers Corner will continue until May 2025. A Traffic Management Plan will be in place to minimise disruption with VM signs to give advance warning of the works.
