# NOTICE TO MARINERS

## **RACING AND TRAINING IN THE HARBOUR LAUNCHING FROM SLIPWAYS**

Attention is drawn to Dun Laoghaire Notice to Mariners No 3 of 2025 which states that there is a requirement for all organisations to request permission in writing from the Harbour Master before training and racing takes place inside the harbour.

**Please email in requests. Whatsapp messaging for requests to run events is not accepted.**

Following any permissions for such training and racing, permission is also given to lay Race Marks in the fairways (unless traffic is expected) - however such marks must be removed at every break in training and on completion of racing.

In any event ALL small craft should keep clear of ALL power-driven vessels including smaller excursion vessels, Motor Fishing Vessels and cruise ship tenders – they have right of way in the Fairways.

All Sailing Instructors and associated RIB drivers should be adequately briefed before any proposed in-harbour sessions and should note that the speed limit within the harbour is 8 knots (15 kph)

**Launching** - All individuals before launching from slipways (or any other area) should ensure:

- Their craft is seaworthy
- They have checked the weather forecast, tide and tidal condition
- They have means of communication with the shore
- When parked, ensure handbrake is on and holding. Open windows to allow escape
- When reversing, if available, use a 2<sup>nd</sup> person to guide you, looking out for others
- They have informed a person ashore they are going to sea and when they will return
- No trolley's or trailers to be left on the slip at any time – areas to be kept clear

Anyone going to sea in recreational craft should be familiar with the ["Code of Practice for: The Safe Operation of Recreational Craft"](http://www.dttas.ie) ([www.dttas.ie](http://www.dttas.ie))

Do not hesitate or be afraid to call the Irish Coast Guard (999, 112 or on VHF Channel 16) at the **first** signs of any emergency – don't wait until it is too late.
