SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF R138 STILLORGAN ROAD

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application to temporarily close R138/Stillorgan Road from Foster's Avenue to Belfield Bridge on **Sunday, 1st June 2025** from 11:30 hours to 16:00 hours in order to facilitate the running of the **VHI Women's Mini Marathon**.

The diversion route is via Foster's Avenue and Roebuck Road.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and the diversion route will be signposted.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE OF CASTLE STREET, DALKEY

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MAIN STREET, DUNDRUM

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MEADOW MOUNT AND MEADOW GROVE

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from Orwell Wheelers to temporarily close Meadow Mount and a section of Meadow Grove, Ballinteer. The proposed closure is to take place from 18:30 hours to 21.30 hours on **Wednesday, 25th June 2025**.

The purpose of the proposed closure is to facilitate the **Stephen Roche GP Cycle Race**.

Diversion of traffic will be via Barton Road East, Meadow Avenue, Meadow Grove, Willow Road and Beech Lawn and vice versa.

ROAD CLOSURES

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GLENAMUCK ROAD, CARRICKMINES

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council had approved an application from BAM Civil Limited for the temporary closure of Glenamuck Road, Carrickmines from its junction with Brambledown housing estate to its junction with Enniskerry Road (Golden Ball T-junction) from Friday, 30th May 2025. The closure has now been deferred and will now commence from **Thursday, 12th June 2025**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

A bus gate will be in place following completion of the road closure, in compliance with granted planning under Section 51 of the Roads Act 1993, which will prohibit through vehicular traffic other than buses.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BARNHILL ROAD, DALKEY

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from GMC Utilities on behalf of Uisce Éireann for the temporary closure of Barnhill Road, Dalkey from its junction with Castle Park Road (roundabout) to its junction with Hyde Road from **Monday**, **9**th **June 2025** to **Friday**, **13**th **June 2025**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is for water and sewer connections.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF M50 SOUTHBOUND BETWEEN JUNCTION 12 (FIRHOUSE) AND JUNCTION 13 (DUNDRUM)

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from M50 Concession Limited for the temporary closure of M50 Southbound Lane between Junction 12 (Firhouse) and Junction 13 (Dundrum). The closure is to run from **Monday, 26th May 2025** to **Saturday, 31st May 2025** between 22:00 hours and 06:00 hours each night. (Night Works)

Baker's Corner, Kill Avenue, Ashgrove

Drainage, utilities, kerbing and footpath works shall continue along Kill Avenue from Baker's Corner to Ashgrove junction. Intermittent Stop/Go traffic management will be in place between 10am and 4pm. The entrance to Ashgrove will remain closed all week. Vehicles will be required to enter and exit the estate through Rose Park entrance. Diversion signs will be in place.
