EVENTS

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FITZGERALD PARK ROAD, DÚN LAOGHAIRE

Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Council has approved an application from Mounttown Community Facility for the temporary closure of part of Fitzgerald Park Road adjacent to the Mounttown Community Facility on **Sunday 29th June 2025** between 14:00 hours and 17:00 hours.

Pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate a family fun day.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MAIN STREET, DUNDRUM

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an order to temporarily close Main Street, Dundrum between its junction with Kilmacud Road Upper to just south of the entrance to the Village Centre Carpark. The closure is to take place from 13:00 hours to 18:00 hours on **Sunday 29th June 2025**.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate the **Dundrum Arts and Cultural Festival**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and all diversions will be signposted.

Pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times.

PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURES

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF WESTMINSTER ROAD. FOXROCK

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application that proposes the temporary closure of Westminster Road, Foxrock from its junction with the N11 to just before its junction with Mart Lane / Golf Lane on **Monday 21st July 2025 to Friday 25th July 2025** between 08:00 hours and 18:00 hours each day.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is for resurfacing works on behalf of DLR Road Maintenance section.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FERNDALE ROAD, SHANKILL

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from GMC Utilities group on behalf of Uisce Éireann that proposes to temporarily close Ferndale Road from Thornhill Road junction to Ballybride Road junction from **Monday, 14th July 2025** to **Friday, 15th August 2025**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the proposed closure is installation of foul connection.

ROAD CLOSURES

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BALLYBRIDE ROAD, SHANKILL

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from GMC Utilities on behalf of Uisce Éireann for the temporary closure of Ballybride Road, Shankill from its junction with Ferndale Road to its junction with Crinken Lane/Dublin Road from **Monday**, **16**th **June 2025** to **Friday**, **11**th **July 2025**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is for sewer connections.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GLENAMUCK ROAD, CARRICKMINES

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council had approved an application from BAM Civil Limited for the temporary closure of Glenamuck Road, Carrickmines from its junction with Brambledown housing estate to its junction with Enniskerry Road (Golden Ball T-junction) from Friday, 30th May 2025. The closure had been deferred, but has now commenced from **Thursday, 19th June 2025.**

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

A bus gate will be in place following completion of the road closure, in compliance with granted planning under Section 51 of the Roads Act 1993, which will prohibit through vehicular traffic other than buses.

Glenamuck District Roads Scheme ***

The Glenamuck District Distributor Road (GDDR), linking Carrickmines Retail Park to De La Salle Palmerston Rugby Club on the Enniskerry Road, opened to traffic on <u>Thursday</u>, <u>19th June 2025</u>.

Following the opening of GDDR, a road closure will be implemented on Glenamuck Road. A Traffic Management Plan will be in place to support both the road opening and associated road closure.

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

» Avondale Road, Killiney***

Trench works will take place from Tuesday 1^{st} July 2025 to Thursday 3^{rd} July 2025 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» Ballinclea Road, Killiney***

Trench works will take place from Tuesday 1^{st} July 2025 to Thursday 3^{rd} July 2025 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» Ballyedmonduff Road & Woodside Road ***

Manhole and valve works will take place on from Monday 30^{th} June 2025 to Friday 4^{th} July 2025 between 08:00 and 18:00 hours.

Traffic and Pedestrian Management Plans will be in place.

» Callery Road & Redesdale Road, Mount Merrion*

Resurfacing of the bituminous Ramps will commence Wednesday 3^{rd} July 2025 for 3 days between 08:00 and 18:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place for the duration of the works.

A letter drop has been distributed to all residents.

» Carrickmines Wood, Brennanstown*

Resurfacing of the bituminous footpaths will continue until Wednesday 2^{nd} July 2025 between 08:00 and 18:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan and VMS will be in place for the duration of the works.

A letter drop has been distributed to all residents.

» Glenageary Road Upper & Adelaide Road, Glenageary***

Footpath and island reconstruction works will take place at these locations on Monday 30th June 2025 and Tuesday 1st July 2025. Works are scheduled between 08:00 and 18:00 hours.

Traffic diversions and a Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» Highland Avenue, Highland Lawn & Highland View, Cabinteely*

Footpath renewal works will commence Friday 27th June 2025 for 6 weeks between 08:00 and 18:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place for the duration of the works.

A letter drop has been distributed to all residents.

» Library Road: Living Streets Dun Laoghaire Phase 1, Active Travel Scheme***

Living Streets Dún Laoghaire project is a mobility and public realm improvement project which aims to enhance the attractiveness, liveability, connectivity, and economic vibrancy of Dún Laoghaire Town.

The site of the proposed works under Phase 1 are undertaken in multiple phases across different locations in Dún Laoghaire including Cumberland Street, Clarence Street, York Road, George's Street Lower, Library Road, Lynch Lane, and Glenageary Wood.

Clonmel Enterprises, working on behalf of Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Council, will commence works on Library Road on Tuesday 2nd July 2025 which will last approximately 5 weeks. The works will include the removal of the existing roundabout and creation of public realm areas with new footpaths, kerbs, signage, crossing pedestrian ramp and landscaping.

The permitted working hours are from 10:00 to 16:00 hours, Monday to Friday.

The works will encompass Library Road from its junction with Rosary Gardens East to IMC car parking entrance.

Stop/Go traffic management plans will be in place for the duration of the works between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

» Mayfield Terrace & Ballinteer Park Ballinteer *

Concrete footpaths renewal and resurfacing of the roadway will commence Wednesday 3^{rd} July 2025 for 10 days between 08:00 and 18:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place for the duration of the works. Some traffic restrictions will be in place due to the diminished working road width.

A letter drop has been distributed to all residents.

» Monkstown Avenue, Monkstown*

The eastbound lane of Monkstown Avenue (towards Dun Laoghaire & Monkstown) will be closed from Monday 30^{th} June at 10:00 to Friday 4^{th} July between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

This closure is required to facilitate works on an amenity area across the road from the Greenville Deli.

Eastbound traffic will be redirected via Stradbrook Road – Windsor Park – Ashton Park.

» N11 southbound***

Grass cutting works on the central median of the N11 will take place on Saturday 28th June 2025 between 06:00 and 14:00 hours.

Works will begin at the UCD underpass and end at the Loughlinstown Roundabout.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» St Fintan's Walk, Deansgrange***

Works on a drinking water connection will take place from Monday 30th June 2025 to Friday 4th July 2025 between 08:00 and 19:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan consisting of a single lane close and a 2 way stop/go system will be in place.

» Sandyford Road, Sandyford***

Works on a sewer connection will take place from Monday 30th June 2025 to Friday $4^{\rm th}$ July 2025 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» Sandyford Road opposite Rathdown Grove***

Joint bay works will take place from Monday 30th June 2025 to Friday 4th July 2025 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan consisting of a traffic light switch-out and a 4 way stop/go system will be in place.

» Wyattville Road, Loughlinstown***

Blockage works will take place on Tuesday 1^{st} July 2025 and Wednesday 2^{nd} July 2025 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Albert Road Lower, Sandycove ***

Reinstatement works will continue until Monday 30^{th} June 2025between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan consisting of a single lane closure and a stop/go system will be in place.

Carrickmines Wood, Brennanstown*

Resurfacing of the bituminous footpaths will continue until Wednesday 2nd July 2025 between 08:00 and 18:00 hours.

A Traffic Management Plan and VMS will be in place for the duration of the works.

A letter drop has been distributed to all residents.

Cumberland Street: Living Streets Dun Laoghaire Phase 1, Active Travel Scheme *******

Living Streets Dún Laoghaire project is a mobility and public realm improvement project which aims to enhance the attractiveness, liveability, connectivity, and economic vibrancy of Dún Laoghaire Town.

The site of the proposed works under Phase 1 are undertaken in multiple phases across different locations in Dún Laoghaire including Cumberland Street, Clarence Street, York Road, George's Street Lower, Library Road, Lynch Lane, and Glenageary Wood.

Clonmel Enterprises working on behalf of Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Council commenced works on the Cumberland Street phase on Thursday, 19th June 2025 which will last approximately 8 weeks. The works will include new footpaths, kerbs, traffic signals, drainage/ducting adjustments, and landscaping.

The permitted working hours are from 10:00 to 16:00 hours, Monday to Friday.

The works will encompass Cumberland Street from its junction with York Road to its junction with De Vesci Terrace.

Intermittent Stop/Go traffic management will be in place if required between 10:00 and 16:00 hours

Druid's Glen Road, Loughlinstown ***

Clonmel Enterprises, working on behalf of Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Council, are undertaking snagging works as part of the Druid Glen Road Scheme. Snagging works will be done on an intermittent basis until Friday 18th July 2025.

Works will take place between 08:00 hrs and 18:00 hours

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Dún Laoghaire Central Active Travel Scheme *** Glenageary Road Upper, Kill Avenue, Mounttown Road Lower, Oliver Plunkett Road

Works at Honeypark Junction started on Monday 23rd June 2025 and will impact traffic flows along all approaches - Kill Ave, Oliver Plunkett Rd, Mounttown Rd Lwr, Glenageary Rd Lwr, Highthorn Rd. This phase of the works will last for about 5 months.

The entrance to Claremount Ave from Kill Ave will remain closed for the duration of this work phase. There will be a traffic light switch out and 4 days of Stop / Go traffic managements in place at Honeypark Junction from Monday 30th June 2025 to Thursday 3rd July 2025 to facilitate excavations across the junction. Higher than normal traffic congestion can be expected over these 4 days.

The main entrance to IADT College off Kill Ave will close from Monday 30th June 2025 for a period of two weeks . Alternative access to the campus will be available at Chestnut Ave off Kill Ave.

Eastern side footpath and lane closure to facilitate ESB Overhead line diversion underground, public lighting upgrade and road realignment commenced on Tuesday, 13th May 2025 and will continue until Thursday, <u>13th November 2025</u> between:

- 07:00 19:00 hours Manually operated Stop/Go.
- 19:00 07:00 hours Vehicle activated traffic lights.
