EVENTS

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MAIN STREET, DUNDRUM

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an order to temporarily close Main Street, Dundrum between its junction with Kilmacud Road Upper to just south of the entrance to the Village Centre Carpark. The closure is to take place from 13:00 hours to 18:00 hours on **Sunday 29th June 2025**.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate the **Dundrum Arts and Cultural Festival**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and all diversions will be signposted.

Pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MEADOW MOUNT AND MEADOW GROVE

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application to temporarily close Meadow Mount and a section of Meadow Grove, Ballinteer. The closure is to take place from 18:30 hours to 21:30 hours on **Wednesday, 25th June 2025**.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate the **Stephen Roche GP Cycle Race**.

Diversion of traffic will be via Barton Road East, Meadow Avenue, Meadow Grove, Willow Road and Beech Lawn and vice versa.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and the diversion routes will be signposted.

Emergency Access can be provided, if required, during the period of the road closure.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FITZGERALD PARK ROAD, DÚN LAOGHAIRE

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from Mounttown Community Facility that proposes the temporary closure of part of Fitzgerald Park Road adjacent to the Mounttown Community Facility on **Sunday, 29th June 2025** between 14:00 hours and 17:00 hours.

Pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times.

The purpose of the proposed closure is to facilitate a family fun day.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FERNDALE ROAD, SHANKILL

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received an application from GMC Utilities group on behalf of Uisce Éireann that proposes to temporarily close Ferndale Road from Thornhill Road junction to Ballybride Road junction from **Monday, 14th July 2025** to **Friday, 15th August 2025**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the proposed closure is installation of foul connection.

ROAD CLOSURES

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BALLYBRIDE ROAD, SHANKILL

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from GMC Utilities on behalf of Uisce Éireann for the temporary closure of Ballybride Road, Shankill from its junction with Ferndale Road to its junction with Crinken Lane/Dublin Road from **Monday, 16th June 2025 to Friday, 11th July 2025**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is for sewer connections.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GLENAMUCK ROAD, CARRICKMINES

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council had approved an application from BAM Civil Limited for the temporary closure of Glenamuck Road, Carrickmines from its junction with Brambledown housing estate to its junction with Enniskerry Road (Golden Ball T-junction) from Friday, 30th May 2025. The closure has now been deferred and will now commence from **Thursday, 12th June 2025**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

A bus gate will be in place following completion of the road closure, in compliance with granted planning under Section 51 of the Roads Act 1993, which will prohibit through vehicular traffic other than buses.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BARNHILL ROAD, DALKEY

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from GMC Utilities on behalf of Uisce Éireann for the temporary closure of Barnhill Road, Dalkey from its junction with Castle Park Road (roundabout) to its junction with Hyde Road from **Monday, 9th June 2025 to Friday, 13th June 2025**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is for water and sewer connections.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1993
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SILCHESTER ROAD, GLENAGEARY

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has approved an application from GMC Utilities on behalf of Uisce Éireann for the temporary road closure of Silchester Road, Glenageary from its junction with Adelaide Road to its junction with Glenageary Road Lower on **Monday, 9th June 2025**.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and pedestrian and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is for installation of sewer/water connections.

» **Convent Road, Blackrock - outside Carysfort National School ****

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are carrying out water main repairs at this location.

Works will take place on Saturday, 7th June 2025 and Sunday, 8th June 2025 between 09:00 and 18:00 hours.

A 2-Way Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» **Lower Road, Shankill ****

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are carrying out sewer and water upgrades at this location.

Works will take place on Thursday, 12th June 2025 and Friday, 13th June 2025 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A 3-Way Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» **Sandyford Road ****

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are carrying out sewer and water upgrades at this location.

Works will take place on Monday, 9th June 2025 until Friday, 13th June 2025 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A 3-Way Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» **Silchester Road, Glenageary ****

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are carrying out sewer and water upgrades at this location.

Works will take place on Monday, 9th June 2025 for one day, between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A 3-Way Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» **Barnhill Road ****

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are carrying out sewer and water upgrades at this location.

Works will take place on Monday, 9th June 2025 until Friday, 13th June 2025 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A 3-Way Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

» **Cherrywood / Wyattville Link Road ****

GMC Utilities, working on behalf of Irish Water, are carrying out rehab works at this location.

Works will take place on Monday, 9th June 2025 until Friday, 13th June 2025 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A 3-Way Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Enniskerry Road R117 from below the Golden Ball junction to just above the junction Ballybetagh Road R116 **
(Night Works)

Eastern side footpath and lane closure to facilitate ESB Overhead line diversion underground, public lighting upgrade and road realignment commenced on Tuesday, 13th May 2025 and will continue until Thursday, 13th November 2025 between:

07:00 – 19:00 hours - Manually operated Stop/Go.

19:00 - 07:00 hours – Vehicle activated traffic lights.

A Stop / Go Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Dún Laoghaire Central Active Travel Scheme ***

Baker's Corner, Kill Avenue, Ashgrove, Claremount Avenue

Drainage, utilities, kerbing and footpath works shall continue along Kill Avenue from Baker's Corner to Claremount Ave. Intermittent Stop/Go traffic management will be in place between 10am and 4pm. The entrance to Claremount Ave will close until further notice. Vehicles will be required to enter and exit Honeypark through Maypark Ave. Diversion signs will be in place.

A Traffic Light Switch Out will occur between 10am and 4pm at Baker's corner on Monday 9th June. Stop/Go traffic management will be in place
