ROAD CLOSURES

»SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT. 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF N11 INBOUND AND OUTBOUND/WYATTVILLE INTERCHANGE**Night Works**

Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close;-

- Wyattville Merge ramp from R118 to Northbound on N11 & Diverge ramp Southbound on N11, 7th April to 21st April 2022, 07:30pm to 05:30am.
- Merge ramp South bound R118 to N11 & Diverge ramp North bound-R118 to N11, 14th April to 28th April 2022, 07:30pm to 05:30am.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate Planning, Resurfacing, Line Marking and Raising of Iron Works.

»SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT. 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF N11 BOOTERSTOWN-KILMACUD LR ROAD(NORTH AND SOUTH BOUND) - Night Works**

Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close N11 Booterstown-Kilmacud Road Lower from Friday 11th April 2022 to Friday 6th May, 2022.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate Planning, Resurfacing, Line Marking and Raising of Iron Works.

» SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT. 1993 *** TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BLACKGLEN ROAD, SANDYFORD, DUBLIN 18

Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council made an order to temporarily close Blackglen Road between the two Junctions with Ticknock Park and Simonsridge from Monday 28th February 2022 to Monday 5th September 2022.

A number of submissions were received in relation to the proposed road closure. These submissions have been considered and the road closure is approved with amended dates, and mitigation measures in place. The road closure will be in place from Monday 28th March 2022 to Monday 3rd October 2022.

The purpose of the proposed closure is to facilitate road works as part of the Blackglen Road improvement scheme.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The proposed diversion route will be via the Loop road and all residents access will be maintained.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and the diversion will be clearly signposted.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT. 1993 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF STONEBRIDGE ROAD, SHANKILL

Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close Stonebridge Road, Shankill from Dublin Road Junction to Mullinastill Road Junction from Monday 11th of April 2022 to Tuesday 12th April 2022.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will always be maintained and diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate Sewer and Water Connections

Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close Mount Merrion Avenue from the junction with Rock Road to the junction with Cross Avenue.

The closure will take place between the hours of **19:30 and 05:30 from Monday the 21st March 2022 to the Sunday 10th April 2022**. The purpose of the closure is to facilitate plaining and line marking works. These works will take place at night because of high traffic volumes during the day.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

SPEED LIMIT ORDER

Road Works <u>Speed Limit</u> Order, No.1 of 2021 on the <u>M50</u> Motorway in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown

Notice is hereby given that Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004, in the interests of road safety and to facilitate the M50 Traffic Flow Optimisation Construction Project; has made an Order entitled Road Works Speed Limit Order, No.1 of 2021 on the M50 motorway in the County of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown to apply a road works speed limit as follows:

M50 Northbound will run from 03 August 2021 until 13 May 2022 or until the end of the works, whichever is the earlier.

Description of Speed Limit order 80km/hr:

- Part of the Northbound M50 between a point 335 metres South of the existing Crinken Lane overbridge to a point 165 metres North of the Crinken Lane overbridge (Total 500m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 between a point 165 metres North of the existing Crinken Lane overbridge to a point 300 metres West of the R113 overbridge (Total 8000m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 17 (M11 Junction 4) from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 70 metres North of the Lordello Road overbridge (Total 450m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 16 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 55 metres East of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 16 (Total 605m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 merge at Junction 16 from a point 80 metres West of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 16 to the end of the merge taper (Total 700m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 15 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 130 metres East of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 15 (Total 500m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 merge at Junction 15 from a point 35 metres North
 of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 15 to the end of the merge
 taper
 (Total 590m in length).

 Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 13 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 420 metres East of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 13 (Total 480m in length).

M50 Southbound will run from 01 November 2021 until 22 December 2022 or until the end of the works, whichever is the earlier.

Description of speed limit order 80km/hr:

- Part of the Southbound M50 between a point 120 metres South of the existing R117 overbridge to a point 620 metres South of the R117 overbridge (Total 500m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 diverge at Junction 14 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 420 metres West of the yield line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 14 (Total 485m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 between a point 620 metres South of the existing R117 Overbridge to a point 120 metres South of the M11 Overbridge (M50 Junction 17/M11 J4) (Total 8,000m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 merge at Junction 13 from a point 50 metres East of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 13 to the end of the merge taper (Total 1250m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 diverge at Junction 15 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 40 metres West of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 15 (Total 555m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 merge at Junction 15 from a point 75 metres South
 of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 15 to the end of the merge
 taper
 (Total 480m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 diverge at Junction 16 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 60 metres West of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 16 (Total 525m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 merge at Junction 16 from a point 65 metres South of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 16 to the end of the merge taper (Total 575m in length).

The Garda Commissioner has been notified by email of the Council's intention **to decrease the Speed Limit** to **80 km/hr** on the **M50** Southbound and Northbound, in accordance with Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004.

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

» 1 Stone Park, Trees Road, Upper Mount Merrion***

GMC Utilities working on behalf of Irish Water are carrying out sewer and drinking water upgrades to the network at this location between 09:30 and 19:00 hrs from Monday 11th April to Friday 15th April.

A single lane closure will be in place with a 2 way stop/go traffic management plan in operation for the duration of the works.

» 8a Woodlawn Park, Monkstown***

GMC Utilities working on behalf of Irish Water are carrying out sewer and drinking water upgrades to the network at this location between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs from Monday 11^{th} April to Friday 15^{th} April.

A single lane closure will be in place with a 2 way stop/go traffic management plan in operation for the duration of the works.

» 117a Barton Road East, Dundrum***

GMC Utilities working on behalf of Irish Water are carrying out sewer connection to the network at this location between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs from Monday 11th April to Friday 15th April.

A single lane closure will be in place with a 2 way stop/go traffic management plan in operation for the duration of the works.

» Brighton Road, Kerrymount, Foxrock***

Gaeltec Utilities working on behalf of ESB are carrying pole works at this location between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs from Tuesday 12th April & Thursday 13th April.

A single lane closure will be in place with a 2 way stop/go traffic management plan in operation for the duration of the works.

» Dundrum Road, opp. Annaville Park, D16

Drainage works to commence at this location.

Works will commence on Monday 11th April 2022 until Friday 15th April 2022 between between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. A traffic management plan will be in operation.

» Stonebridge Road, Shankill***

GMC Utilities working on behalf of Irish Water are carrying out sewer and drinking water upgrades to the network at this location between 09:00 and 20:00 hrs from Monday 11th April to Wednesday 13th April.

A single lane closure will be in place with a 2 way stop/go traffic management plan in operation for the duration of the works.

» Torquay Road and Galloping Green, Foxrock***

Gaeltec Utilities working on behalf of ESB are carrying pole works at this location between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs from Tuesday 12th April & Thursday 13th April.

A single lane closure will be in place with a 2 way stop/go traffic management plan in operation for the duration of the works.

Ballyedmonduff Road, Stepaside*

Subject to the availability of the line marking contractor, road marking and installation of studs will continue here from to Friday 15th April 2022. The works will take place between 10:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A traffic management plan will be in place.

Farrenboley Park, Dundrum**

Installation of traffic poles and signage will take place from Tuesday 5th April 2022 to Thursday 14th April 2022 between 08:00 and 18:00 hours.

A stop /go traffic management plan will be in place at certain phases of the works. Kerbside works will be also be in operation.

Meadow Mount, Churchtown, D14**

Concrete kerb and road marking works to continue at the above location until Friday 15th April from 08.00 and 18:00 hrs.

A traffic management plan will be in operation.

N11 Stillorgan Road Southbound from N31 Mount Merrion Avenue Junction to Priory Drive Junction** (Night Works)

Civil works and resurfacing will continue at N31 Mount Merrion Avenue junction to N11 Stillorgan Road junction to Priory Drive Junction from Monday 11th April 2022 to Tuesday 12th April 2022, between 19:30 and 05:00 hrs.

Local diversions will be required due to the closure of traffic lanes. A traffic management plan will be in place.

N31 Mount Merrion Road from N31 Mount Merrion Junction to Cross Avenue Junction (Night Works)**

Planing and resurfacing take place from Monday 11^{th} April 2022 to Wednesday 13^{th} April 2022 between 19:30 and 05:00 hrs.

A traffic management plan will be in place.

N11 Stillorgan Road from Dublin Road Junction to Lower Kilmacud Road Junction** (Night Works)

Civil works and road resurfacing will continue at N11 Stillorgan Road from Dublin Road Junction to Lower Kilmacud Road Junction from Monday 11^{th} April 2022 to Thursday 14th April 2022 between 19:30 and 05:00 hrs.

Local diversions will be required due to the closure of traffic lanes. A traffic management plan will be in place.

N11 - Wyattville Intersection - N11 inbound diverge ramp & N11 outbound merge ramp ** (Night Works)

Planing and resurfacing take place from Wednesday 13th April 2022 to Thursday 14th April 2022 between 19:30 and 05:00 hrs.

A traffic management plan will be in place. Local diversions will be required due to the closure of traffic lanes.

#Rathsallagh Drive & Clifton Park, Ballybrack**

Footpath restoration and associated works will continue on Rathsallagh Drive & and Clifton Park until Friday 15th April 2022 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A traffic management plan will be in operation.

Roebuck Road, Clonskeagh **

Tree trimming and hedgerow management on Roebuck Road will continue until 15th April 2022.

A traffic management plan will be in place.

St Laurence's Park, Stillorgan-Stillorgan Library Site***

Drainage works will take place at this location from Monday 4^{th} April 2022 to Friday 15^{th} April 2022 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours. Due to the nature of the works, it will be necessary to close the footpath and part of the slip lane leading from St Laurence's Park to the N11 inbound.

A traffic management plan will be in operation for the duration of these works.

The Heights, Woodpark, Ballinteer*

New footpath and tactile paving will be installed at this location to alleviate trip hazards on footpath and uneven surface at pedestrian crossing.

Works will commence on Monday 4th April 2022. until Friday 15th April 2022 between between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs. A traffic management plan will be in operation.

Trees Road, Mount Merrion, Co. Dublin **

Pedestrian improvement works at Trees Avenue, Cherry Garth, The Rise Junctions are ongoing. Pedestrian improvement works will continue to Friday 15th April 2022 between 09:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A stop /go traffic management plan will be in place at certain phases of the works. Kerbside works will be in also be in operation.

Village Road, Aiken's Village, Sandyford**

Installation of traffic poles and signage will take place from Tuesday 5th April 2022 to Thursday 14th April 2022 between 08:00 and 18:00 hours.

A stop /go traffic management plan will be in place at certain phases of the works. Kerbside works will be also be in operation.

Avondale Road **

Footpath reconstruction works, driveway resurfacing and cycletrack surface patching will commence on Avondale on Thursday 7th April 2022 from 08.00 and 18:00 hrs for approximately 3 weeks.

A stop / go traffic management plan will be in operation.

Ballinteer Road, Ballinteer ***

Ongoing works on wall at Dundrum Wood have ceased for the moment but a new footpath layout has been implemented and will be maintained until the issues with a dangerous wall are resolved.

A traffic management plan will be in operation.

Bellevue Road, Glenageary **

Road Reconstruction on Bellevue Road, Glenageary will commence on Monday 4th April 2022 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs. Works are scheduled to conclude by Friday 29th April 2022.

A traffic management plan will be in operation.

Clonskeagh Road Cycle Scheme***

Provision of footpaths, cycleways, junction buildouts, new kerbing, and all associated works will commence on Monday, 4th April 2022 until 30th November 2022 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A traffic management plan will be in operation.

Dublin Road, Shankill**

Replacement of public lighting columns will take place from Monday 4th April 2022 to Friday 22nd April 2022 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A stop /go traffic management plan will be in operation.

Woodbrook Downs, Shankill ***

Works at Woodbrook College are complete; however, road works will continue on the R119 Dublin Road at Woodbrook Downs for approximately 8 weeks.

Works will take place between 10.00 & 16.00 hrs Monday to Friday. Delays should be expected during working hours.
