ROAD CLOSURES

»SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT. 1993
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF N11 BOOTERSTOWN-KILMACUD LR
ROAD(NORTH AND SOUTH BOUND) - Night Works**

Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Council has made an order to temporarily close N11 Booterstown-Kilmacud Road Lower from Monday 11th April 2022 to Friday 6th May 2022.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in operation and local access will be maintained at all times. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.

The purpose of the closure is to facilitate Planning, Resurfacing, Line Marking and Raising of Iron Works.

SECTION 75 OF THE ROADS ACT. 1993 *** TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BLACKGLEN ROAD, SANDYFORD, DUBLIN 18

Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council made an order to temporarily close Blackglen Road between the two Junctions with Ticknock Park and Simonsridge from Monday 28th February 2022 to Monday 5th September 2022.

A number of submissions were received in relation to the proposed road closure. These submissions have been considered and the road closure is approved with amended dates, and mitigation measures in place. The road closure will be in place from Monday 28th March 2022 to Monday 3rd October 2022.

The purpose of the proposed closure is to facilitate road works as part of the Blackglen Road improvement scheme.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The proposed diversion route will be via the Loop road and all residents access will be maintained.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place and the diversion will be clearly signposted.

SPEED LIMIT ORDER

Road Works Speed Limit Order, No.1 of 2021 on the M50 motorway in the County of Dún Laoghaire Rathdown

Notice is hereby given that Dún Laoghaire Rathdown County Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004, in the interests of road safety and to facilitate the M50 Traffic Flow Optimisation Construction Project; has made an Order entitled Road Works Speed Limit Order, No.1 of 2021 on the M50 motorway in the County of Dún Laoghaire Rathdown to apply a road works speed limit as follows:

M50 Southbound will run from 07/02/2022 until 1st December, 2022 or until the end of the works, whichever is the earlier.

Description of speed limit order 80km/hr:

- Part of the Southbound M50 between a point 120 metres South of the existing R117 overbridge to a point 620 metres South of the R117 overbridge (Total 500m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 diverge at Junction 14 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 420 metres West of the yield line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 14 (Total 485m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 between a point 620 metres South of the existing R117 Overbridge to a point 120 metres South of the M11 Overbridge (M50 Junction 17/M11 J4) (Total 8,000m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 merge at Junction 13 from a point 50 metres East of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 13 to the end of the merge taper (Total 1250m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 diverge at Junction 15 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 40 metres West of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 15 (Total 555m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 merge at Junction 15 from a point 75 metres South
 of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 15 to the end of the merge
 taper
 (Total 480m in length).
- Part of the Southbound M50 diverge at Junction 16 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 60 metres West of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 16 (Total 525m in length).

Part of the Southbound M50 merge at Junction 16 from a point 65 metres South
of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 16 to the end of the merge
taper
(Total 575m in length).

M50 Northbound will run from 03 August 2021 until 01 November 2022 or until the end of the works, whichever is the earlier.

Description of speed limit order 80km/hr:

- Part of the Northbound M50 between a point 335 metres South of the existing Crinken Lane overbridge to a point 165 metres North of the Crinken Lane overbridge (Total 500m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 between a point 165 metres North of the existing Crinken Lane overbridge to a point 300 metres West of the R113 overbridge (Total 8000m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 17 (M11 Junction 4) from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 70 metres North of the Lordello Road overbridge (Total 450m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 16 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 55 metres East of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 16 (Total 605m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 merge at Junction 16 from a point 80 metres West of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 16 to the end of the merge taper (Total 700m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 15 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 130 metres East of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 15 (Total 500m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 merge at Junction 15 from a point 35 metres North
 of the start of the merge on-ramp at M50 Junction 15 to the end of the merge
 taper
 (Total 590m in length).
- Part of the Northbound M50 diverge at Junction 13 from the start of the diverge taper to a point on the diverge ramp 420 metres East of the stop line of the diverge off-ramp at Junction 13 (Total 480m in length).

The Garda Commissioner has been notified by email of the Council's intention to decrease the speed limit to 80 km/hr on the M50 Southbound and Northbound, in accordance with Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004.

ROADWORKS / LANE RESTRICTIONS

» 1 Stone Park, Trees Road Upper, Upper Mount Merrion Dublin

GMC Utilities working on behalf of Irish Water are carrying out sewer upgrade works to the network, between the hours of 09:30 and 19:00, Tuesday the 3rd May 2022 to Thursday 05th May 2022.

A stop go system will be in operation.

» Bray Road, Cabinteely***

Gaeltec Utilities working on behalf of ESB are carrying out pole works at this location between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs on the 4^{th} May 2022

A traffic management plan in operation for the duration of the works.

» Oakdown Road, Churchtown, Dublin 14.***

Reinstatement of concrete footpaths to begin between the hours of 10:00 and 16:00, Tuesday the 3rd May 2022 to Friday 27th May 2022.

A Traffic Management system will be in place.

» Pavillion Gate, Carrickmines***

» N31 Frascratti Road, Blackrock, Dublin / Junction of R113 Temple Hill ** (Night Works)

Line Marking of roadway will take place on Tuesday 03rd May 2022 between 19:30 and 23:00 hrs.

Traffic management will be in place for the works operated by Free Flow Traffic Management

»N11 Stillorgan Road Northbound from old Dublin Road Junction to N11 Stillorgan Road, N31 Mount Merrion Road Junction** (Night Works)

Planing and resurfacing will continue at N11 Stillorgan Road Northbound from Lower Kilmacud Junction to N11 Stillorgan Road, N31 Mount Merrion Road Junction from Tuesday 03rd 2022 May to Friday 6th May 2022 between 19:30 and 05:00 hrs.

Local diversions will be required due to the closure of traffic lanes. A traffic management plan will be in place.

»Wyattville Intersection N11 Outbound Diverge Ramp & N11 inbound Merge Ramp** (Night Works)

Raising of Ironworks and high friction surfacing will continue from Tuesday the 3rd May 2022 to Thursday 05th May 2022 between 19:30 and 05:00 hrs.

A traffic management plan will be in place.

Avondale Road **

Footpath reconstruction works, driveway resurfacing and cycletrack surface patching will commence on Avondale on Thursday 7th April 2022 until Tuesday 03rd May from 08.00 and 18:00 hrs.

A stop / go traffic management plan will be in operation.

Ballyedmonduff Road, Stepaside*

Subject to the availability of the line marking contractor, road marking and installation of studs will continue here to Friday 06^{th} May 2022. The works will take place between 10:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A traffic management plan will be in place.

Bellevue Road, Glenageary **

Road Reconstruction on Bellevue Road, Glenageary will commence on Monday 4th April 2022 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs. Works are scheduled to conclude by Friday 20^{th} May 2022.

A traffic management plan will be in operation.

Dublin Road, Shankill**

Replacement of public lighting columns will take place from Monday 4th April 2022 to Friday 27th May 2022 between 10:00 and 16:00 hours.

A stop /go traffic management plan will be in operation.

#Dundrum Road, opp. Annaville Residence, D16

Lining works to commence at this location.

Works will commence on Monday 11th April 2022 until Friday 06th May 2022 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs. A traffic management plan will be in operation.

Meadow Mount, Churchtown, D14**

Kerbing and Landscaping to continue at the above location until Friday 06th May from 08.00 and 18:00 hrs. A traffic management plan will be in operation.

N31 Mount Merrion Road from Cross Avenue Junction ** (Night Works)

High Friction surfacing work will take place on 06th May 2022 between 19:30 and 05:00 hrs.

A traffic management plan will be in place.

Rathsallagh Drive, Shankill & Clifton Park, Ballybrack**

Road restoration and associated gully repairs will commence on Rathsallagh Drive during the week commencing Monday 1st May 2022 until Friday 13th May 2022 between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs.

A traffic management plan will be in operation.

St Laurence's Park, Stillorgan-Stillorgan Library Site***

Drainage works will take place at this location from Monday 4th April 2022 to Tuesday 03rd May between 10:00 and 16:00 hours. Due to the nature of the works, it will be necessary to close the footpath and part of the slip lane leading from St Laurence's Park to the N11 inbound.

A traffic management plan will be in operation for the duration of these works.

Ballinteer Road, Ballinteer ***

Ongoing works on wall at Dundrum Wood have ceased for the moment but a new footpath layout has been implemented and will be maintained until the issues with a dangerous wall are resolved.

A traffic management plan will be in operation.

Brighton Road, Foxrock***

Construction of a new section of footpath along the front boundary of the development on Brighton Road, between the hours of 10:00 and 16:00, from Monday 25th of April 2022 to Friday 29th of April, and again on Monday 2nd of May to Tuesday 3rd of May.

A Traffic Management Plan will be in place.

Clonskeagh Road Cycle Scheme***

Provision of footpaths, cycleways, junction buildouts, new kerbing, and all associated works will commence on Monday, 4th April 2022 until 30th November 2022 between 10:00 and 16:00 hrs.

A traffic management plan will be in operation.

Pearse Gardens, Sallynoggin**

Footpath reconstruction and patching works to commence on Pearse Gardens, Sallynoggin from the 26th April to 3rd May from 08.00 and 18:00 hrs.

Narrowing of Lane TTM will be in operation.

Sans Souci Park, Bootertown Avenue***

Concrete footpath restoration works will commence at this location between 08:00 and 18:00 hrs from Tuesday 19th April to Friday 6th of May 2022.

A traffic management plan in operation for the duration of the works.
